GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Exhibition is held under the rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all.

Each Exhibit will be examined on arrival by the Club's Hon. Vet. Surgeon. Exhibits which are unfit for exhibition will be removed from the Hall immediately, and, if in her estimation it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same cattery, and the owner thereof shall be debarred from attending the show. All entry fees are forfeited.

Staging and pens will be provided. Exhibits will be received at the Hall on Saturday, from 9.30 a.m. All exhibits to be penned by 10.45. Judging commences at 11 o'clock.

Every exhibit must be accompanied to the Hall by the owner or some responsible person.

Tallies will be forwarded to each exhibitor, and must be hung round the neck of the exhibit by means of white tape or ribbon. In case tallies do not reach the exhibitor, application must be made at the office on arrival at the Show.

Exhibits may be entered in any class for which they are eligible but separate fees must be paid for each class. Neuters can only enter in Neuter classes. Exhibits entered in any of these classes may not compete in Household Pet classes.

The Show closes at 5 o'clock. No exhibits may be removed before that time, except under special circumstances and after application to the Show Manager.

Registration.—All exhibits except Household Pets and litters must be registered with the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy for which forms are enclosed. Extra forms can be obtained from Mr. W. A. Hazeldine, 1, Roundwood Way, Banstead, Surrey. All registered cats which have changed owners since registration must be transferred.

Kittens or Cats entered in Brace classes must be entered in at least one other class.

SHOW RULES

Exhibits are only received on the condition that the Club shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits, boxes or baskets or in any way.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of their exhibits and in the event of any dispute arising after purchase shall (on proof of false or erroneous entry) receive back the exhibit, and refund the purchaser the full amount paid and shall forfeit the commission charged on the sale by the Committee.

Exhibitors must state clearly the price at which they are prepared to sell their kittens, and no reduction can be made in prices during the exhibition except on payment of 2/- per kitten. Ten per cent. commission will be charged on the catalogue price of all sales (which does not include basket or blanket). All sales must be made through the SALES TABLE and kittens must be paid for at the time they are claimed. All exhibits having been passed by the Vet. before admission to the Show, the Club cannot hold themselves responsible for kittens bought through the Sales Table.

Any Exhibitor in any way interfering with or removing any exhibit from its pen during the Show, except with the consent of the Show Manager, will forfeit any prize which may have been awarded to his or her cat.

No decoration or distinguishing objects are allowed in or on the pens during judging, and judges are instructed to pass any exhibit so distinguished. White blankets without markings, sanitary pans, and a small water container only are allowed in the pens.

No printed or written matter other than the official award cards may be put on the pens. Exhibitors wishing to sell their exhibits may affix a "for sale" card which must have been signed at the Secretary's table.

Judges are empowered to withhold any prize if the exhibits do not in their opinion possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be paid from the judges' award slips. Should any judges be unable to fulfil their engagement the Committee reserves unto itself the right to appoint another.

Exhibits will be sold from the entry forms only, and the Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse any entry without giving reason.

Entries unaccompanied by the proper amount of fees will not be accepted, and no class will be divided on request of any exhibitor unless he or she is prepared to guarantee both classes.

Exhibits actually received in the Show Hall cannot be withdrawn from competition without the sanction of the Committee.

An announcement in "Fur and Feather" of any alteration or additions to this Schedule or these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

Peat Moss Litter will be provided, **BUT EVERY EXHIBITOR MUST PROVIDE FOOD AND SANITARY PANS FOR THEIR EXHIBITS.**

NO correspondence will be answered unless **A STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE IS ENCLOSED.**
