SHOW RULES

Exhibits are only received on the condition that the Club shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits, boxes, or baskets, or in any way.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of their exhibits, and in the event of any dispute arising after purchase shall (on proof of false or erroneous entry) receive back the exhibit and refund the purchaser the full amount paid, and shall forfeit the commission charged on the sale by the Committee.

Exhibitors must state clearly the price at which they are prepared to sell their kittens, and no reduction can be made in prices during the exhibition except on payment of 2/- per kitten. Ten per cent. will be charged on the catalogue price of all sales (which does not include basket or blanket). All sales must be made through the SALES TABLE, and kittens must be paid for at the time they are claimed. All exhibits having been passed by the Vet. before admission to the Show, the Club cannot hold themselves responsible for kittens bought through the Sales Table.

Any exhibitor in any way interfering with or removing any exhibit from its pen during the Show, except with the consent of the Show Manager, will forfeit any prize which may have been awarded to his or her cat.

No decorations or distinguishing objects are allowed in or on the pens during judging, and judges are instructed to pass any exhibit so distinguished. White blankets without markings, sanitary pans, and a small water container only are allowed in the pens, and these must be supplied by the exhibitor, who is also advised to furnish a small cushion to place under the blanket.

After all judging is finished, exhibitors will be allowed half an hour before the admission of the public in which to decorate their pens if they so desire. A Special Prize will be offered for the best decorated pen.

The Judge is empowered to withhold any prize if the exhibits do not in her opinion possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be paid from the Judge's award slips. Should the Judge be unable to fulfil her engagement, the Committee reserves unto itself the right to appoint another.

The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse any entry without giving reason.

Entries unaccompanied by the proper amount of fees will not be accepted.

Exhibits actually received in the Show hall cannot be withdrawn from competition without the sanction of the Committee.

An announcement in "Fur and Feather" of any alterations or additions to this Schedule or these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

Peat moss litter will be provided, but EVERY EXHIBITOR MUST PROVIDE FOOD FOR THEIR EXHIBITS.

NO correspondence will be answered unless a STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE IS ENCLOSED.

Entries close on Saturday, 27th January, 1951, and under no circumstances will late entries be accepted.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

OPEN.—Open to all.

NOVICE.—For exhibits which have not won a first prize under G.C.C.F. Rules.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS' CLASS.—The exhibitor never having shown at any Cat Shows.

CHILDREN'S CLASS.—Owned and attended by a child under 14.

NEUTERS.—These Cats can only compete in the Classes for neutered cats.

BRACE.—Two Cats or Two Kittens of either sex and any colour belonging to the same exhibitor. Judged on individual merit.

ADULT.—Nine months and over.

KITTEN.—Three to nine months.

VETERAN.—Over five years old.
