SHOW RULES and REGULATIONS

The Exhibition is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, and is open to all.

The Cats will be received at the entrance to the Show on Saturday, January 20th from 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m.

Each Exhibit will be examined on arrival by the Club's Hon. Vet. Surgeons who will be in attendance. Cats which in their opinion are unfit for exhibition will be returned to the owners. No exhibit is to be penned before being examined by the Club's Vet. Surgeons; any Exhibitor so doing will be disqualified from competition, and all fees paid forfeited. **This Rule must be strictly enforced.**

All Exhibits must be accompanied by owner, or representative. Exhibitors must provide their own food, sanitary pans and drinking bowls. Peat Moss is provided at the Hall. Kit-E-Kat will be on sale in the Hall, also warm and cold milk for Exhibits. **TALLIES** will be placed in the pens, and must be hung round the neck of each exhibit by means of a **white** ribbon or tape.

Registration. All exhibits (except Neuters and Household Pets) must be registered with the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, for which Forms are enclosed. Extra Forms can be obtained from Mr. W. A. Hazeldine, 1 Roundwood Way, Banstead, Surrey. All registered Cats which have changed owners since registration **must** be transferred.

Exhibits actually received into the Show Hall cannot be withdrawn from the competition without the Committee's sanction.

No interior or exterior decoration, or distinguishing objects will be allowed in or on the pens during the judging under any circumstances whatever, and it will be an instruction to the Judges to pass any pen so distinguished. Small white blankets without markings and sanitary tins will be allowed.

The right to cancel or amalgamate classes is reserved.

Early Removals. No cat may be removed from its Pen before 6 p.m. Cats may be removed at 4.30 at a charge of 2/6 each cat. Failure to observe this rule will result in forfeiture of prize money.

Entries Close December 20th (Postmark), and should be sent on or before that date to Miss Marjorie E. German, 21 Bath Road, Felixstowe. Telephone 352.

Entry Forms must be accompanied by the proper amount of fees, otherwise they will not be accepted.

Exhibitors may view the judging at 10 a.m. from the Stage at an inclusive entrance fee of 1/-. The general public will be admitted from 1 to 4 p.m. at 1/- entrance fee; children, 6d.; after 4 p.m. the entrance fee will be 6d. for adults and 3d. for children.

Refreshments will be on sale all day in a room at the rear of the Hall. Lunches (3/6) will only be served if reserved beforehand. Please send your money with Entrance Forms.

Staging & Pens. These will be supplied by Messrs. Benches Ltd. There will be a benching fee of 1/- for pedigree cats and 6d. for household pets. Double Pens 2/6 each.

MEMORANDA

Registration. fanciers should register their cats and kittens in good time. If they leave it to the last moment and the names they submitted are not available, they may not receive their registration in time to enter.

The Committee have the absolute right to fix and limit the number of exhibits at their Shows, and to select, accept or refuse any offers of exhibits and fees from members or others at their discretion, without giving reason for so doing. Exhibits are only received on the condition that the Club shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to cats, boxes or baskets or in any other way.

No stud advertisement or written or printed matters of any kind other than the official award cards may be put on pens.

Exhibitors wishing to advertise for sale a cat or kitten which is not priced in the catalogue, must apply at the Secretary's Table for an official "For Sale" card.

Any exhibitor in any way interfering with or removing any cat from its pen during the Show, except with the consent of the Show Manager, will forfeit any prize that may have been awarded to his or her cat. No one may remove any exhibit from its pen except the owner or a Club Official.

No kittens can be entered or shown in Adult Classes unless stated for cat or kitten.

Should any Judges be prevented from fulfilling their engagements, the Committee reserve to themselves the right of appointing other Judges in their stead.

Definition of Classes

NOVICE. For Cats and Kittens that have not won a First Prize under G.C.C.F. Rules. Wins as Kittens do not disqualify in Cat Classes unless Class is for Cats or Kittens.

KITTENS. For Kittens under 9 months old on the day of Show. Kittens under 2 months may not be shown, except in Litter Class.

BREEDERS. For Cats or Kittens bred by Exhibitor.

SENIOR. For Cats two years old or over on day of Show.

JUNIOR. For Cats under two years old on day of Show.

LITTER. For three or more Kittens of the same litter over three weeks and under three months. If under two months, must be accompanied by mother or foster.

NEUTER. Any cat, male or female, which has been "doctored."

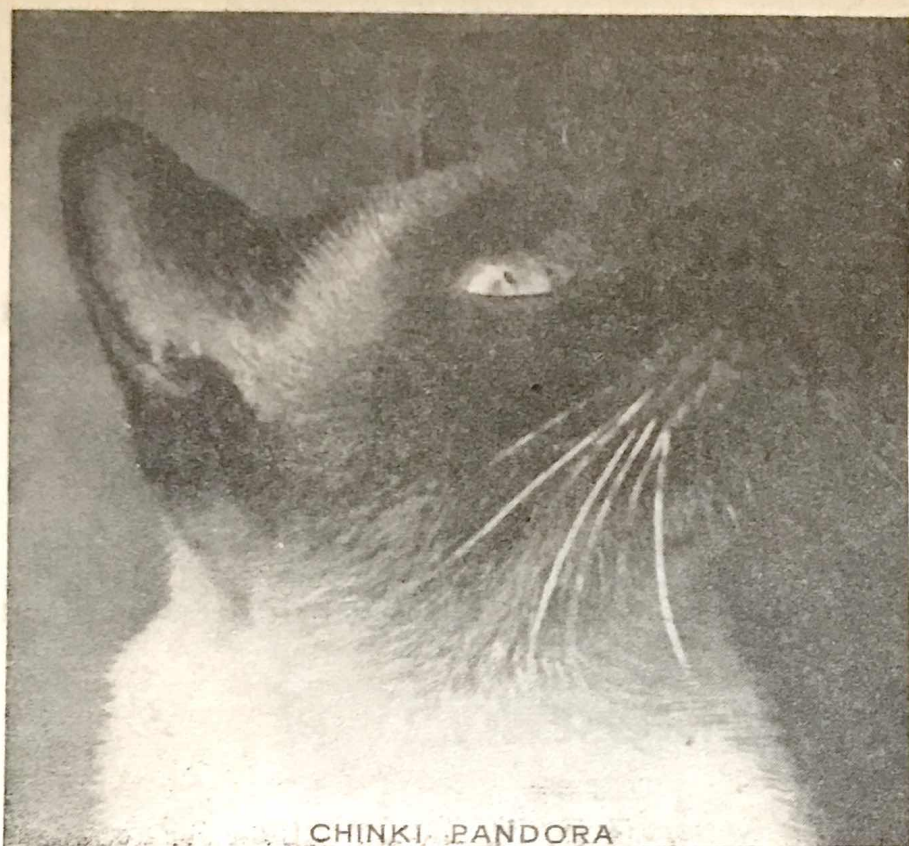

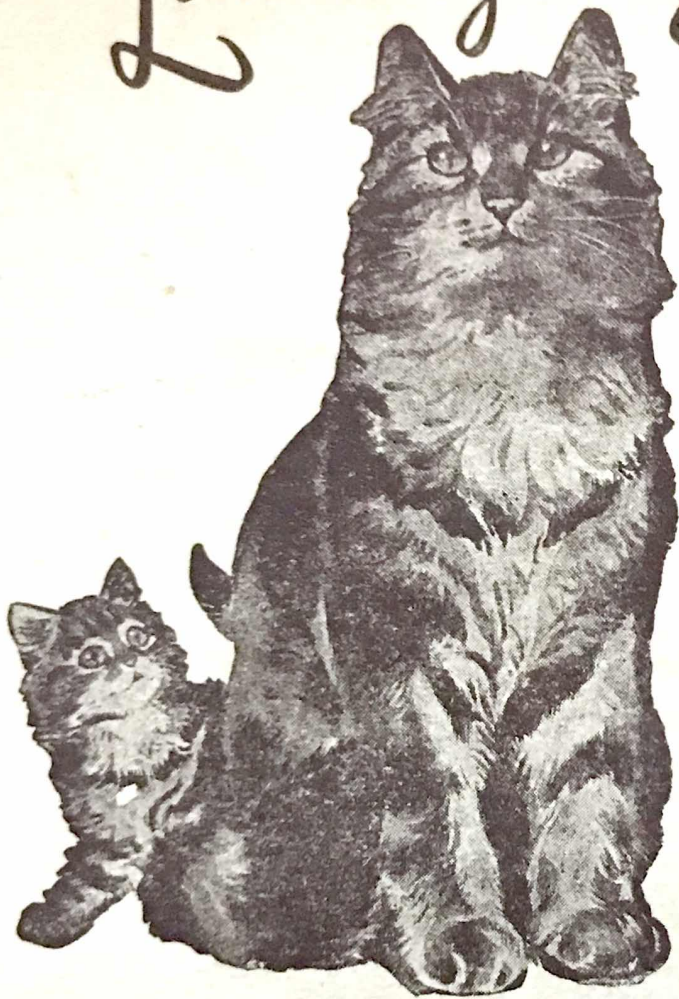

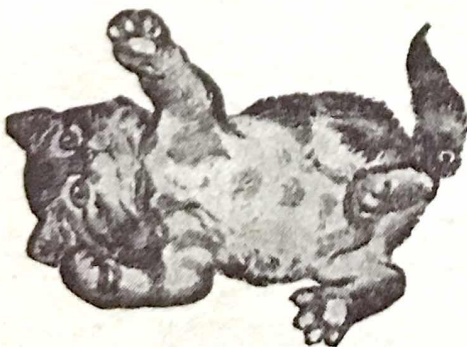
