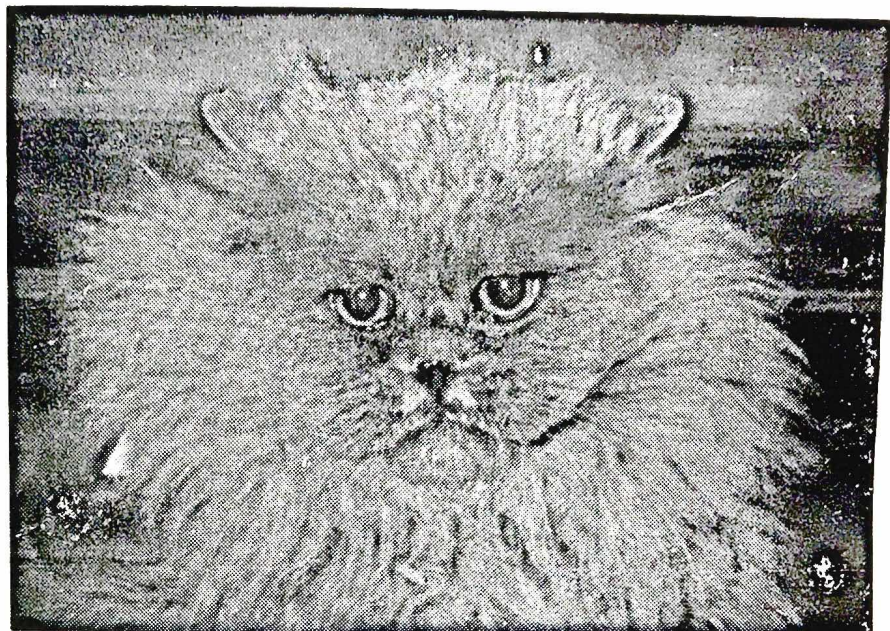

SHOW RULES.

1. All cats are eligible for this Show if registered with the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, Mr. W. A. Hazeldine, Roundwood Way, Banstead, Surrey.

2. Exhibits at the Club's Shows are only received on the condition that the Club shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to cats, boxes or baskets, or in any other way.

3. The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any of the Classes. Full prize money will be paid in all Classes. Exhibitors are requested to cash their cheques at once, so that the Show account can be closed.

4. Exhibitors must fill correctly, sign and deliver the Club's authorised entry form before any Show takes place, and they are held solely responsible for the right description of their exhibits, and if prepared to sell same, must state the price on the entry form. Should any description of an exhibit so sold be found to be false or erroneous after sale, the exhibitor must receive back the exhibit and refund the purchase money in full. No cat can be claimed until 4 p.m. on the day of the Show, and if there should be more than one claimant the cat must be put up to auction.

5. Sale of exhibits must be made at the SHOW MANAGER'S TABLE ONLY, and payment made at the time they are claimed. Ten per cent. will be deducted from all prices paid. If there are two or more claims for the same exhibit it will be offered by auction at 4 p.m., and 50 per cent. deducted over and above all such catalogue price, and no alteration can be made in price during the Exhibition except by payment of 2/- per cat. Price of cat does not include the basket.

6. Judges are empowered to withhold any prize or Championship in any Class if the exhibits do not in their opinion possess sufficient merit.

7. Prizes will be paid from the Judges' Award Slips, and exhibits sold from the entry forms only.

8. Small white blankets and small sanitary tins, without colour or marks, will be allowed in pens. Judges are instructed to pass any pens containing decorations or distinguishing objects.

9. Should any of the Judges be prevented from fulfilling their engagements, the Executive Committee reserve to themselves the right of appointing other Judges to fulfil their duties.

10. The prescribed declaration on the Club's Show entry form that the exhibitor is the BONA FIDE OWNER of the exhibit, and that the exhibit is offered for exhibition subject to the Club's Show Rules and Regulations, must be signed and forwarded to the Show Secretary with the entry fees. If a cat belongs to more than one person, both must be members to compete for cups, etc.

11. No cats or kittens will be accepted unless accompanied by their owner or representative on both journeys.

12. Exhibits actually received into the Show Hall cannot be withdrawn from competition without the Committee's sanction.

13. The Committee reserve to themselves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.

14. An announcement in "Fur and Feather" of any alteration or addition made in the Schedule or in these Regulations, shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.

15. No late entries will be accepted under any condition.

16. Exhibitors wishing to advertise for sale a cat or kitten, which is not priced in the Catalogue, must apply at the Secretary's Table for an official "For Sale" card.

17. Should any exhibit be disqualified by the examining Veterinary Surgeon it must leave the Hall immediately, and if in his opinion it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same cattery and the owner thereof, shall be debarred from attending the Show.

GENERAL REGULATIONS AND RULES FOR THIS SHOW.

The Exhibition is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all.

A Penning Fee of 1/- will be charged on single pens and 2/6 for double pens.

RECEIPT OF EXHIBITS will take place at the entrance to Drill Hall, where the Show will be held, from 7 p.m. until 9 p.m. of the evening previous to the opening day, 8th January, 1953, and also before 9.30 a.m. of the opening day, 9th January, 1953.

The Show will be open to the public at 12.30 o'clock. Admission 1/6. Tickets, 10 a.m. to 5.30 p.m., 2/6, but before 12.30 o'clock it must be distinctly understood that no one will be allowed in the gangways.

NOTE: The required number of tallies will be forwarded to each exhibitor, which must be hung round the neck of each exhibit by means of a white ribbon or tape. Receipt for entry fees will be forwarded with tallies.

NO EXHIBIT TO BE PENNED before being examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeons. Any exhibitor so doing will be disqualified from competitions and all fees paid forfeited.

This rule must be strictly enforced.

AFTER JUDGING IS OVER, no exhibit must be removed from its pen other than by exhibitor.

This rule applies to everyone, and must be strictly enforced in the general interest.

EARLY REMOVALS. Exhibitors from a distance of 75 miles, if desirous of removing any exhibit, may do so at 5.0 p.m. free of charge, otherwise 2/6 will be charged for each single exhibit, 2/- if two or more; under special passes issued by the Show Manager.

JUDGING will commence at 10.15 a.m. on 9th January, 1953.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES.

KITTENS. For Kittens not exceeding 9 months old on the day of Show.

LIMIT CLASSES. For Cats or Kittens which have not won more than four 1st prizes under the Governing Council Rules.

SPECIAL LIMIT CLASSES. For Cats or Kittens which have not won more than two 1st prizes under the Governing Council Rules.

NOVICE CLASSES. For Cats or Kittens which have not won a 1st prize at Shows under the Rules of the G.C.C.F.

MAIDEN CLASS. For Cats or Kittens which have not won 1st, 2nd, or 3rd prizes at Shows under the Rules of the G.C.C.F.

SENIOR. For Cats over two years old on day of Show.

JUNIOR. For Cats under two years old on day of Show.

BRACE. For two Cats belonging to the same exhibitor, each of which must be entered in at least one other Class.

PAIR. For two Kittens belonging to the same exhibitor, each of which *must* be entered in at least one other class.

Brace exhibits are judged on individual merit, Pairs on their similarity to each other.

NOVICE EXHIBITORS' CLASS. For Cats or Kittens whose owners have never won a prize.

RADIUS CLASSES. For exhibitors residing north of a line drawn through the town of Trent, Derbyshire.

NEUTERS can only compete in their own Classes.

STUD CATS. To be judged by progeny only. Both must be present.

BROOD QUEENS. To be judged by progeny only. Both must be present.

BREEDERS. For Cat or Kittens bred by exhibitor.

Stud Cats and Brood Queens will be penned with their own particular breed.

LITTER CLASS. For three or more Kittens of the same litter, over 2 and under 3 calendar months on the day of the Show.

CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATES.

N.B. The following Rule was passed at the Meeting of the G.C.C.F. held on 10th July, 1935:—

“When the number of exhibits in the two open Classes is below seven, only one certificate should be given. If, however, the winner of the opposite sex be of very high quality, the Judge may be empowered to give the second championship, subject to the approval of another recognised Judge of that breed, who must initial award slip.”
