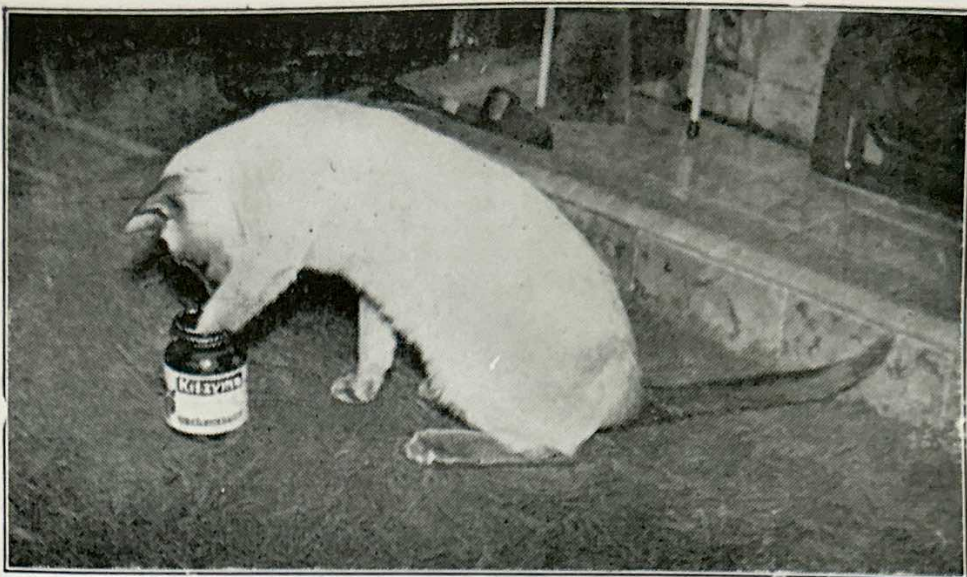

Show Rules and Regulations

CAT SECTION

The Exhibition is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all.

Exhibits will be received on Saturday morning, August 5th, from 8.30-9.45 a.m. Judging will commence 10.30 a.m.

All exhibits must be examined by the Show Veterinary Surgeons before being penned. Any exhibits which in their opinion are unfit for exhibition will be returned to their owners and all entry fees will be forfeited. All exhibits must have clean ears and be free from vermin. No queen in kitten may be exhibited, and no nursing queen may be exhibited except as a brood queen, nor must she be separated from the whole of her litter.

No kitten may be shown or sold under the age of two calendar months.

All exhibits must be accompanied by the owner or owner's representative throughout their journey.

White blankets and sanitary trays **must** be provided by exhibitors. Tallies will be sent to exhibitors. These must be hung round the neck of each exhibit by means of white tape or white ribbon and not removed until after the Best in Show judging. No interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing objects will be allowed in or on the pens during the judging. Peat moss will be provided.

Cats and kittens must be entered in at least two classes if eligible. A separate fee for each class must be paid. No kitten can be entered in any adult class unless specified for cat and kitten. Neuters may only compete in neuter classes.

The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason, and to cancel and amalgamate classes.

No cat or kitten may be removed from its pen before **6 p.m.** unless permission for earlier removal has been given by the Show Manager at her discretion in the case of exhibitors who live over 75 miles from the Show Hall. **APPLICATION FOR EARLY REMOVAL MUST BE MADE WITH ENTRY FORMS.**

Benching fee 1/6d. per cat (all pens will be large single ones).

ENTRIES CLOSE JULY 15th (postmark) and should be sent on or before that date to **MRS. C. PRINCE, c/o Show Committee Office, Cat Section, Kingsway Hospital, Kingsway, Derby.**

The Show will be open to exhibitors from **1.0 p.m.** Public admitted **5.15 p.m.—6.0 p.m.**

The Governing Council of the Cat Fancy.

Exemption Show Rules 1961.

1. All exhibits must be carefully examined by a Veterinary Surgeon before being penned.
2. All exhibits must be accompanied throughout their journeys by the owner or the owner's representative.
3. A litter may not be shown under the age of two calendar months, nor may a kitten or kittens be sold at any Show under this age.
4. No Queen in kitten nor any nursing queen may be exhibited. A nursing queen may, however, accompany her litter.
5. The Show Schedule and Catalogue must both distinctly state on the covers that Exemption has been granted by the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy for the exhibition of registered Cats.
6. A copy of the Schedule, as soon as it is published, and *two* marked Catalogues signed by the Show Manager, must be forwarded to the Secretary immediately after the Show.
7. Prizes and Awards should not be paid out or handed over till the Catalogue has been checked and notification so to do has been received from the Secretary.
8. Particulars of all exhibits must be printed in the Show Catalogue.
9. Only the names of Clubs or of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy can be used for rosettes.
10. Only first prize winners in Open Classes can be brought out for Best in Show.
11. Only Judges recognised by the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy may officiate except in the case of Household Pets Classes.
12. Neuters shall count as progeny. Neuters can only compete for prizes and specials confined to Neuters.
13. The G.C.C.F. pattern Award Cards must be used. Copies enclosed.
14. All alterations in judges and absent exhibits must be entered in the marked Catalogues.
15. A full copy of the above Rules must be printed in each Schedule and Catalogue.
16. Subject to the above conditions, a Club or Society is free to run a Show under its own Rules.

Note.—Neuter Kittens may enter Neuter Classes only.

Junior. For cats under two years on day of Show.

Senior. For cats over two years on day of Show.

Breeders. For cats or kittens bred by exhibitors.

Novice. For cats or kittens that have never won a first prize. Wins as kittens do not qualify in cat classes unless class is for cats and kittens.

Neuters. Can only compete in Neuter Classes.

Litter. For three or more kittens of the same litter over two and under two calendar months on August 5th, 1961. No kitten entered in a litter class may be entered in any other class.

Household Pets. For cats not registered with the Governing Council.

Brace. For two cats, two kittens, or cat and kitten.
