

It supports all the principal Shows by guaranteeing Classes and offering Special Prizes for its members.

The B.P.C.S. holds a Championship Show annually. At these Shows Members have the privilege of entering their Cats at reduced fees.

The Club has its own Pedigree Forms, obtainable from the Hon. Secretary (price 3/- per dozen, post free).

The Annual Subscription is 10/-, with an Entrance Fee of 5/-. Life Member £5-5-0. Year starts on September 1st.


WARNING.—Breeders and Owners are hereby warned by the Governing Council against the danger of selling WHOLE LITTERS to ONE BUYER, as unfortunate consequences may follow.

SHOW RULES

- 1. All Blue Persian Cats are eligible for this Show if registered with the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy.
- 2. Exhibits are received only on the condition that the Committee shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to Cats, Boxes or Baskets, or in any other way.
- 3. The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any of the Classes. Full prize money will be paid in all Classes. Exhibitors are requested to cash their prize money cheques at once, so that the Show Account can be closed early.
- 4. No Stud Advertisement or written or printed matter of any kind other than the official Award Card may be put on the pens. Exhibitors wishing to advertise for sale a Cat or Kitten, must apply at the Show Manager's table for an official "For Sale" card.
- 5. Judges are empowered to withhold any prize in any Class if the Exhibits do not, in their opinion, possess sufficient merit.
 - 6. Prizes will be paid from the Judges' award slips.
- 7. No interior or exterior decorations or distinguishing objects will be allowed in or on the pens during the judging under any circumstances, and the Judges will be instructed to pass any pen so distinguished. Small white blankets without markings, and sanitary tins, must be provided.
- 8. Should any of the Judges be prevented from fulfilling their engagements, the Committee reserve to themselves the right of appointing other Judges to fulfil their duties.
- 9. Entries unaccompanied by proper amount of fees will not be accepted.
- 10. Exhibits actually received into the Show Hall cannot be withdrawn from competition without committee's sanction. Exhibits must be brought in boxes or baskets of adequate size.
- 11. An announcement in "Fur and Feather" of any alteration made in the Schedule, or in these Regulations, will be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- 12. The Committee reserve to themselves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.

SPECIAL NOTICE.—14 day Rule. No exhibit may be shown more than once within 14 days.

NOTICE.—Any Cat found suffering from the effects of drugs on entry or at any time during the Show will be subject to expulsion from the Show on the authority of the Honorary Veterinary Surgeon.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SHOW

- THE EXHIBITION is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, and is open to all.
- Exhibits will be received at the entrance to the Show on Thursday, October 27th, from 8.30 a.m. to 10 a.m., when a Veterinary Surgeon will be in attendance. We regret that as we are unable to have the use of the Hall on Wednesday, no Exhibits can be penned overnight.
- THE SHOW WILL BE OPEN at 10.30 a.m. to visitors desiring to view the judging, and to the Public at 12 noon. The Show will close at 5.30 p.m., after which hour exhibits must be immediately removed.
- EACH EXHIBIT will be examined on arrival by the Club's Hon. Veterinary Surgeon. Exhibits which are unfit for exhibition will be removed from the Hall immediately, and if, in his estimation it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same cattery and the exhibitor thereof shall be debarred from attending the Show. All Entry Fees are forfeited.
- Numbered Tallies will be forwarded to each exhibitor. These must be hung around the neck of each exhibit by means of WHITE ribbon, tape or elastic.
- EARLY REMOVALS. No exhibit can be removed before 5.30 p.m. except by special permission of the Show Manager.
- JUDGING will commence at 10.30 a.m. and the judging for Best Exhibit will take place at 3 p.m. (approx.).
- CATS AND KITTENS may be entered in more than one class, if eligible, but separate fees for each class must be paid.
- CATS AND KITTENS entered in Pair and/or Team or Club Classes must be entered in their Open or Breeders' Class also.
- ALL CATS AND KITTEMS will be accepted only if accompanied by the owner or representative on both journeys.
- No KITTEN can be entered in any Adult Class unless the Class is stated for Cat or Kitten.
- Double Pens. These will be provided (space permitting) at a charge of 3/6 per pen extra to penning fee.
- CATALOGUES 2/6 each. By post after Show, with results, 3/6 each on application to the Show Manager.

Prentis, 4 Farman Street, Hove, 2, Sussex (Siamese), or Mrs. E. Aitken, Bourneside, Kingswood Lane, Hindhead, Surrey (L.H. and S.H.). All registered Cats which have changed owners since registration MUST be transferred. All Neuters competing for the title Premier MUST be registered.


DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

- Novice. For Cats and Kittens that have not won a First Prize under G.C.C.F. Rules. Wins as Kittens do not disqualify in Cat Classes unless Class is for Cats or Kittens.
- KITTENS. For Kittens under 9 calendar months old on the day of Show. Kittens under 3 months may not be shown except in Litter Classes. At no period of the year may a litter be shown or a Kitten or Kittens sold at any Show under the age of 10 weeks.
- Breeders. For Cats and Kittens bred by Exhibitor.
- SENIOR. For Cats two years old or over on day of Show.
- JUNIOR. For Cats under two years on day of Show.
- LITTER. For three or more Kittens under three months and over ten weeks on day of Show Kittens in Litter Class cannot be entered in any other Class.
- LIMIT. For Cats that have not won more than four First Prizes.
- SPECIAL LIMIT. For Cats that have not won more than two First Prizes.
- TEAM. For three Exhibits belonging to the same owner. Each Exhibit must be entered also in at least one Class other than Brace.

 N.B.—A Team may consist of Cats, Cats and Kitten, Cat and Kittens, or Kittens.
- MAIDEN. For Exhibits that have not won a First, Second or Third Prize in any Show held under G.C. Rules.
- NEUTERS. Can compete only in their own Classes, Cat or Kitten.
- NEUTER KITTENS cannot compete in Premier or Open Kitten Classes.
- RADIUS. For Exhibits belonging to residents within 25 miles of Show Hall.
- Brace. For two Cats belonging to same Exhibitor, each of which must be entered in at least one Class other than Team Class.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

- CHAMPIONSHIPS. Two Governing Council Championships will be granted where separate classes are scheduled for each sex, provided the total number of entries in the two classes is SEVEN OR MORE. In cases of amalgamation or where the total entry in the two classes is less than SEVEN, only the one Championship will be given.
- The following rule was passed at the meeting of the G.C.C.F. held on the 10th July, 1935:
 - "When the number of Exhibits in the two Open Classes is below seven, only one certificate should be given. If, however, the winner of the opposite sex be of very high quality, the Judge may be empowered to give the second championship subject to the approval of another recognised judge of that breed."

Beware Cat Thieves!

Every day, in many parts of the country, especially in

London, cats are being stolen.

Cat thieves tour the streets at night in vans. (Always take the number of any vehicle you suspect). They carry bait to tempt any cats that may be out. Many cats fall easy victims, and are whisked away. Most of them never see their homes again. Their owners tramp the streets looking for them; they ask at the police stations and cat shelters; they advertise in the newspapers. But puss never comes back. Only the memory of him remains.

CATS SHOULD NOT BE OUT AT NIGHT

Never let your cat stay out at night. If you do, he may be picked up by thieves, and you will never see him again. It is **wrong** to put a cat out at night. Even in the daytime your pet is not really safe from thieves. Cats are sometimes stolen in daytime.

WHAT HAPPENS TO STOLEN CATS?

A few may be sold for their furs or for other purposes, but most of them are sold for vivisection: that is, for painful experiments in their living bodies. The thieves sell them to dealers, who re-sell them to vivisection laboratories. If you want to know what happens to them in the laboratories, send for our leaflet "Experiments on Cats."

ARE THIEVES EVER CAUGHT?

Sometimes, but not often. Below are particulars of some recent cases that came before the courts. If you will keep a sharp lookout there may be more prosecutions. IT IS UP TO YOU.

22nd June, 1961. At Downham Juvenile Court a boy was fined £5 for stealing a widow's cat. He sold it for 10/- to a man who had offered that sum for any cat brought to him.

10th August, 1962. The 'Edinburgh Evening News' reported that a livestock dealer had been fined £85 for having 252 stolen cats in his possession. Detectives discovered that he made his living by selling live cats to laboratories for 25/- apiece and skins of dead cats for 30/-each.

20th July, 1963. According to the 'Daily Mail,' reporting a case at the Pembrokeshire Assizes, at Haverfordwest, a detective told of an admission by Winston Hafferman that he kept coshes in his car for knocking out stolen cats in order to sell them to a laboratory in Cheshire.




