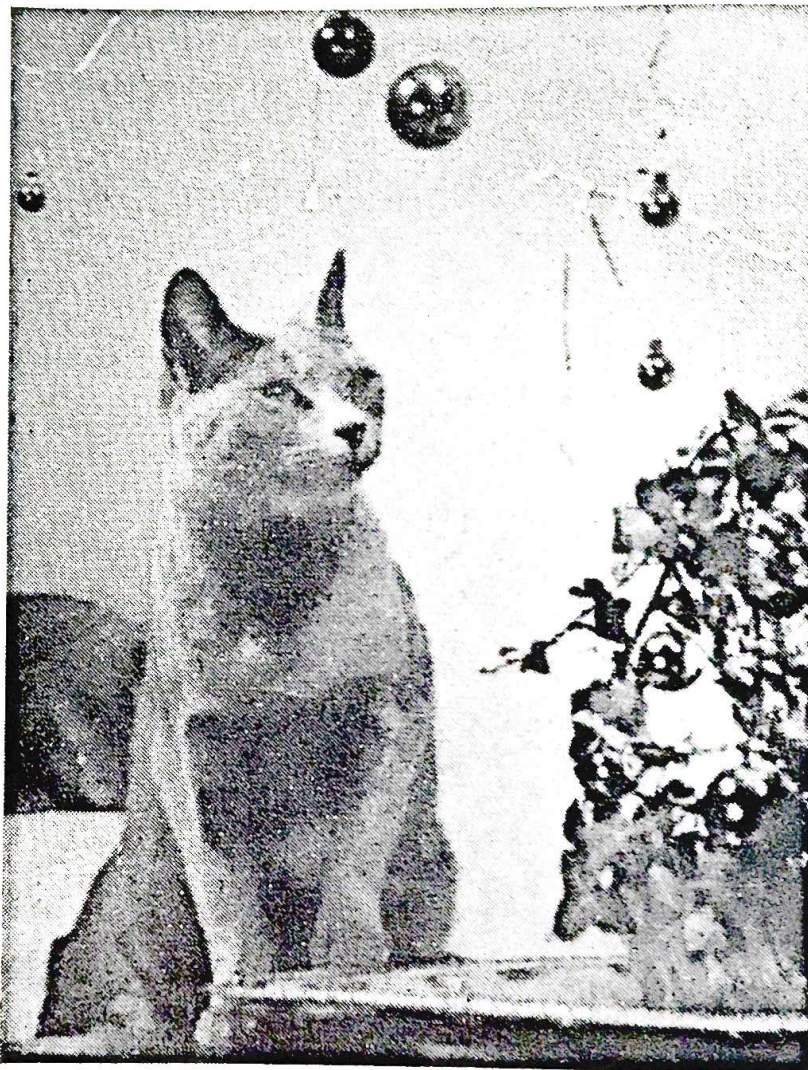

RUSSIAN BLUE :

The Russian Blue is a long-bodied graceful cat with long legs and tail and small oval feet. The head should exhibit a short wedge with a flat skull, while the forehead and nose should be straight. The eyes should be a bright, particu-

larly vivid green, set rather wide apart and almond in shape. The coat colour should be truly blue without shading or ghost tabby markings once the cat is adult. Medium blue is preferred. In texture, the coat should be short, thick and very fine, standing up soft and silky as does the fur on a seal skin and in direct contrast to that of the other Foreign Breeds, where the coat is required to be flat lying. The coat should be double and show a definite silvery sheen.

Maryinska was also Best Russian Blue Exhibit at Croydon and winner of the Darlington Manchy Trophy and the Ch. Stephanie of Cadonmuir Cup. She was absolutely unbeatable in Open Classes. Her Best in Show win was a notable step forward for Russian Blues and is thought to be the first time such an honour was accorded to the breed at a Championship Show for fifteen years.

She died suddenly on 22.4.67 of a suspected inter-uterine haemorrhage. Her pen today is occupied only by her photograph and her owners wish those who sympathise with them to do so in a practical way by supporting the Central Fund for Feline Research in its efforts to support research into the reproductive and other disorders of cats, about which so little is known.

He has been exhibited three times, once as a member of the winning litter at Suffolk & Norfolk, where they were awarded the Orwell Cup, once at Croydon, where he won first place, and lastly at Kensington, where he was just beaten by his brother (another member of the winning litter).

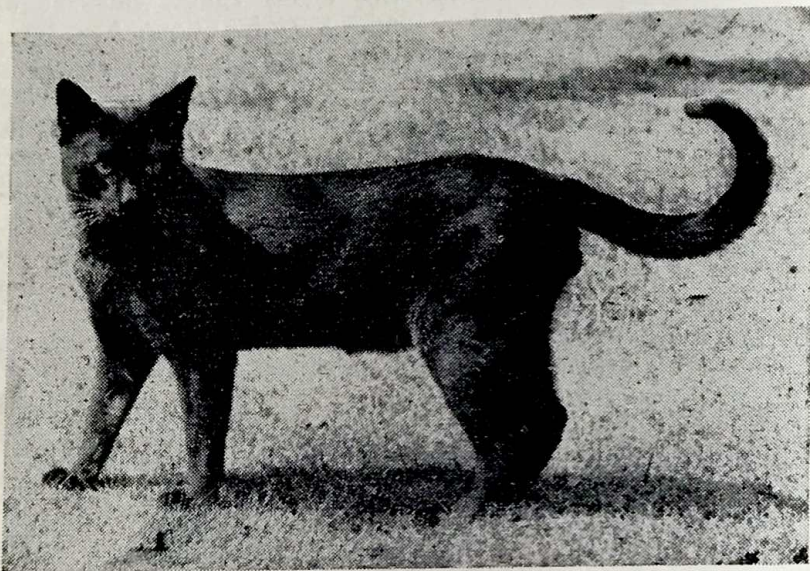

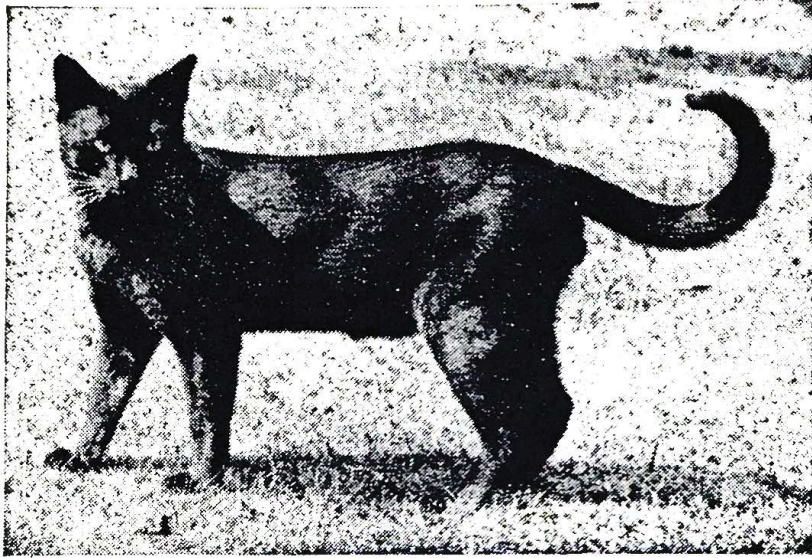

BURMESE :

The Burmese is a medium sized cat of long svelte appearance. The neck is long and slender, the legs proportionately slim, and the feet small and oval in shape. The hind legs should be slightly higher than the front ones. The tail should be long and tapering and a kink is only permissible at the extreme tip. The head should be short wedged with a slight rounding at the top of the skull. The ears should be pricked and relatively large and wide at the base. The eyes should be almond in shape and slanting towards the nose in true Oriental fashion. Blue eyes and squints are inadmissible. The coat should be glossy, short and fine in texture and should lie close to the body. In colour it should be brown (Breed 27) or blue (Breed 27a).

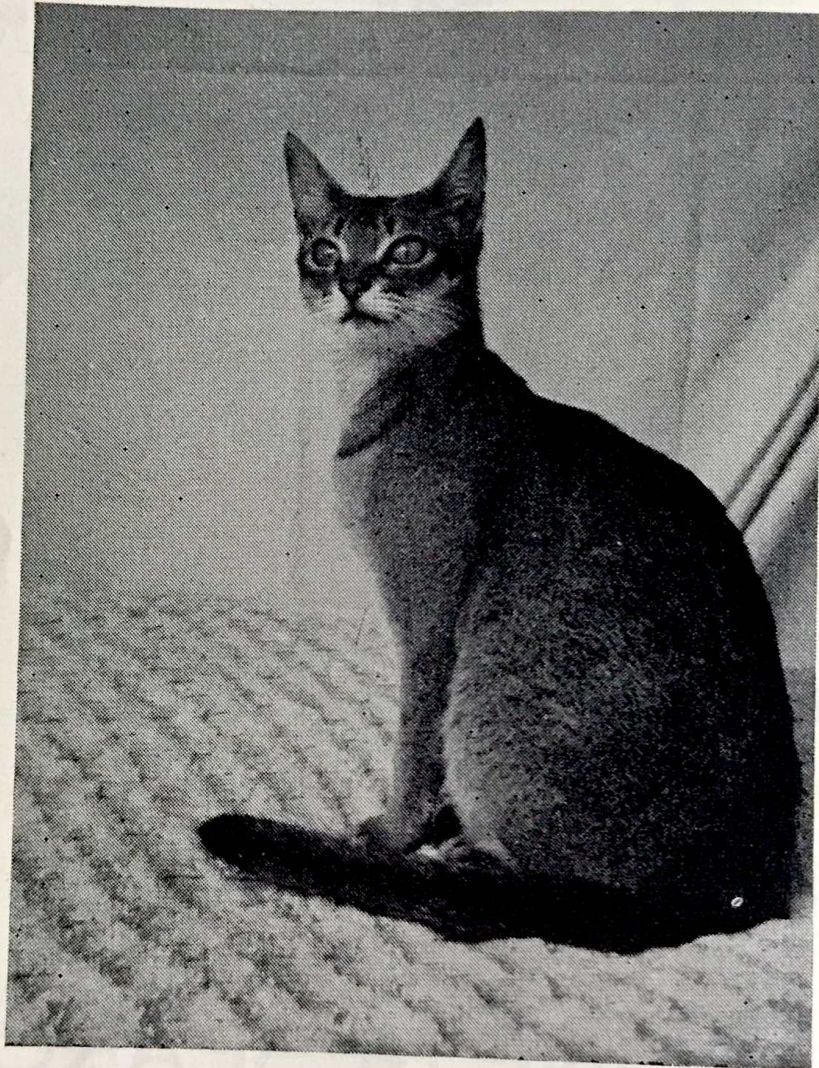

ABYSSINIAN :

The Abyssinian should be ruddy brown, ticked with black or dark brown. The ticking can be double or treble, i.e., two or three bands of colour on each hair. This is preferable to single ticking. There should be no bars or other markings other than a dark spine line. The inside of the forelegs and belly should be of a tint to harmonise well with the main colour, the preference being given to orange less markings visible the better. The head should be long and pointed, the ears sharp and comparatively large and broad at the base. The eyes should be bright and expressive and green, yellow or hazel in colour. The tail should be fairly long and tapering. The feet should be small and the pads and a section of the fur at the back of the hind legs. The coat should be short and fine. Abyssinians should never have distinct bars on legs or tail, nor should they have any suspicion of a white chin or, indeed, of any other white markings.

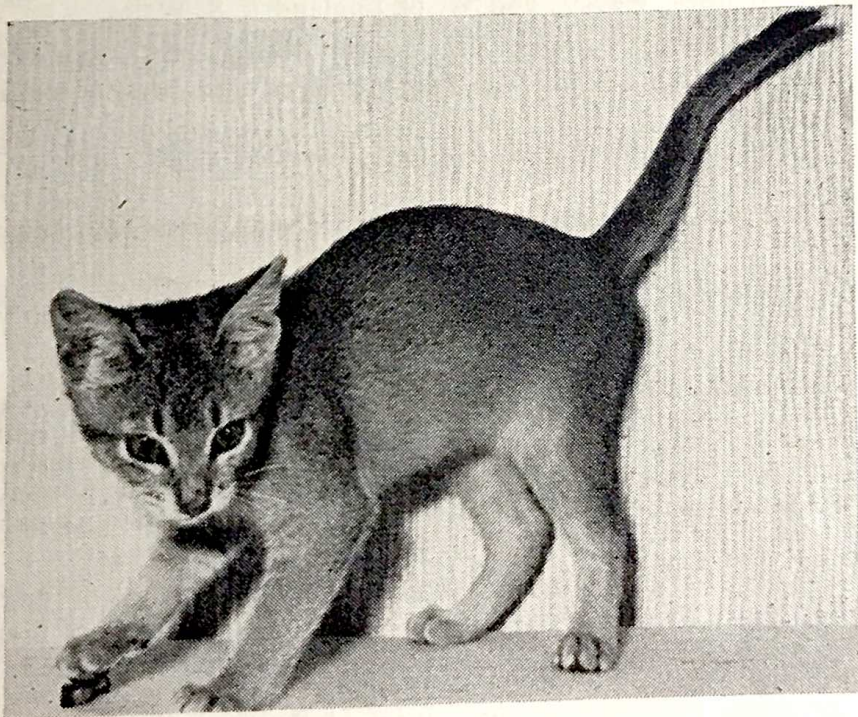

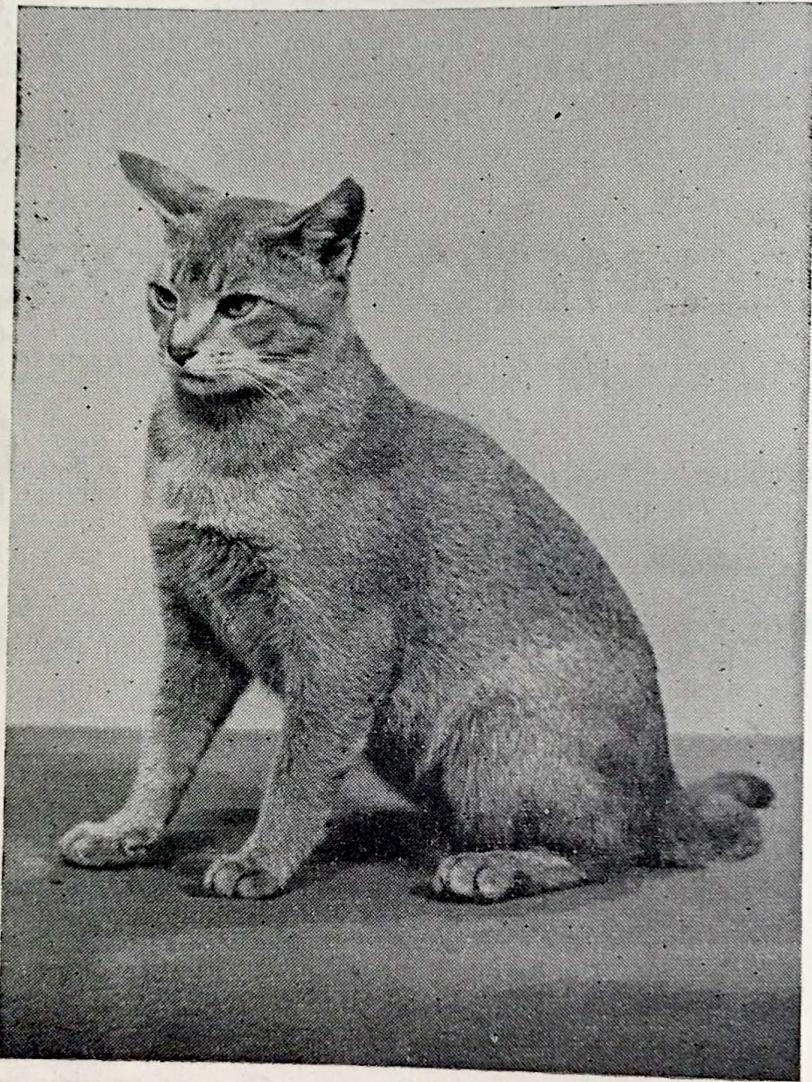

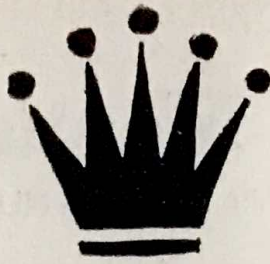

CORNISH REX :

The Cornish Rex is one of the newest varieties recognised by the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy. The most important single factor in judging Rex is in the coat quality, which should be dense, very short and fine and with waves over the entire body other than the head, legs and paws. On these areas the coat should resemble dense short plush. The whiskers and eyebrows should also be crinkled. The Cornish Rex is of foreign type and the head shows a very characteristic straight profile. The head should be medium to long and should narrow to a strong chin. The eyes should be almond shaped, of medium size, and their colour should be in keeping with the coat colour and pattern, which may be of any variety recognised by the G.C.C.F. for the straight-coated classifications.

As a result, several of the early breeders unintentionally crossed these two genes and found themselves with straight-coated cats from curly-coated parents.

Curly Coon is phenotypically Cornish and when bred to Cornish cats both she and her progeny breed true. It is now apparent that she must inherit the Cornish genes from the female side of both parents' pedigrees.

Her kittens are sired by Rio Vista Kismet, whose pedigree goes back to the same line of Cornish cats as the hybrids in her own pedigree.

DEVON REX

The Devon Rex were officially recognised as a breed last February. They are of Foreign type and should own dense, very short, fine wavy coats. Fifty points are allocated to coat under the Standards of Points and any tendency to bareness is considered a fault. The head of the Devon Rex is quite different to that of the Cornish, being short-muzzled and showing a nose with a definite stop in profile. The eyes should be almond shaped as in the Burmese and Russian Blue and in colour they should be in keeping with the coat colour and pattern, which may be of any variety recognised by the G.C.C.F. for the straight-coated classifications.

Both hybrids carry Siamese coat pattern from the female side of the pedigree. Boucle's sire, Briarry Waitrose, is grandson of Briarry Cutie, a White carrying Siamese coat pattern. Therefore the fact that her litter brother is a Seal-Pointed Devon Rex came as no great surprise to her breeders and he will be a very valuable outcross for queens of the other line. Boucle herself inherits her white coat from her sire. Her white coat masks self-colour as she has blue eyes. However, there is a definite chance of her producing Blue-eyed White Rex if she is mated to a Siamese-patterned Devon Rex Stud.

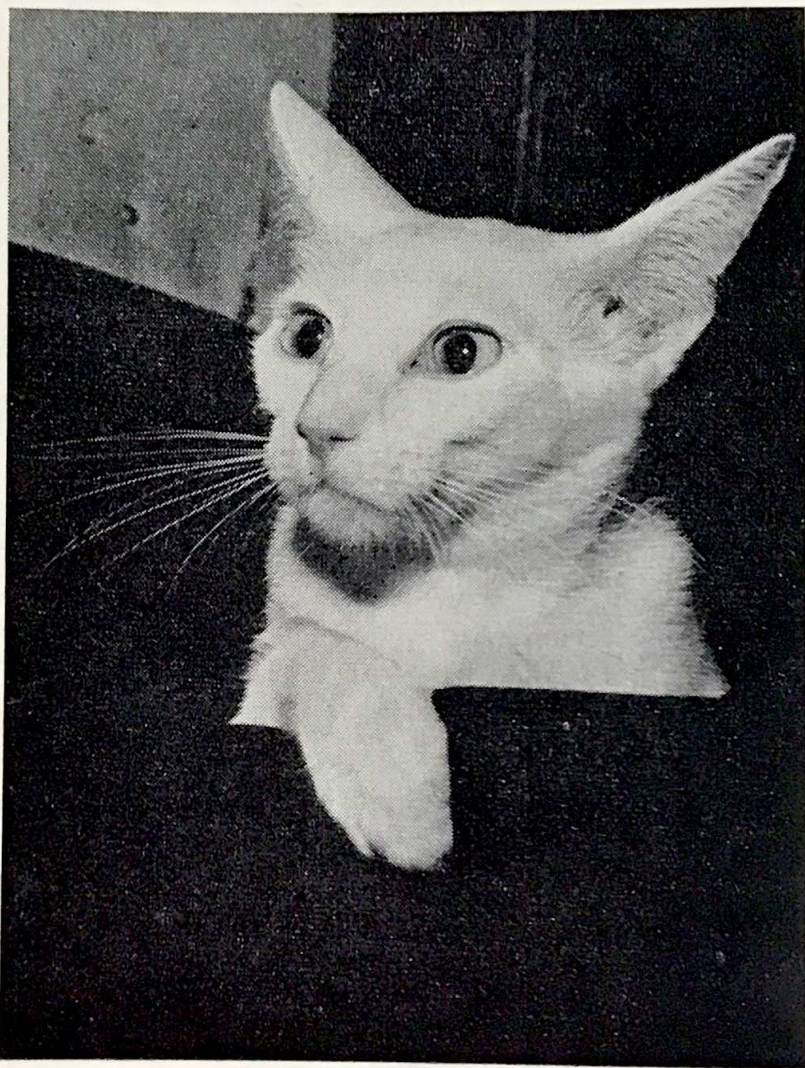

FOREIGN WHITE :

The Foreign White is one of the newest and most attractive breeds, having all the qualities of a Siamese together with the added beauty of a pure white coat. Eventually Foreign Whites will be entirely Siamese with generations of Siamese ancestors—the only difference will be that they will hide their points colour under their white coats. At present, Foreign Whites may have either golden or blue eyes, but the golden eyes automatically disappear after about the third generation from the original cross. The actual blue to be aimed at has not been decided, most probably it will be that of the Blue-Point, this colour being very striking when seen with pure white coat. The Foreign White breeding programme back-

FOREIGN WHITE (continued)

crosses to Siamese in each strain until the cats are one hundred per cent. Siamese but wearing white "overcoats." At that stage whites are mated to whites until no Siamese kittens are produced. The Foreign White will then be truly a breed. Foreign Whites are dominant Whites and not albino Siamese. Since their blue eye colour is the blue of the Siamese they all have perfect hearing. Despite their frail appearance, they are one of the most vigorous and hardy varieties of all cats. The cats on exhibition include first, second, third and fourth generation Foreign Whites; some exhibit blue eyes and others golden. All the strains being developed by the Foreign White Cat Society members are represented.

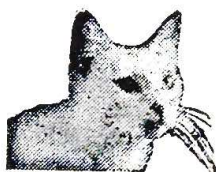

RED, CREAM, TORTIE & BLUE-CREAM BURMESE

In 1964, a small group of breeders set out to establish new colours in the breed. Eventually, having reached the first step of breeding Tortoiseshell and Blue-Cream females (each being a fascinating combination of intermingled colours—the former being brown, red and cream and the latter blue and cream) these mated back to Brown and Blue Burmese produced the first Red and Cream males. Not until the Tortie and Blue-Cream females have been mated to the Red and Cream males can Red and Cream females be produced.

The colours were first introduced into the breed by a Blue Burmese female mating "wild" with a Short-Hair Red Tabby. Then a Tortie-and-White Short-Hair female (which unexpectedly proved to carry Siamese) was mated to a Brown Burmese male and a Brown Burmese female was crossed with a Red-Pointed Siamese male. Despite the fact that two British cats were used originally. Foreign type has predominated and the majority of kittens bred in the generations to follow have been of good Burmese type—this is now being further improved by mating back to good Brown and Blue Burmese cats. By breeding for quality breeders do not always get quantity, as the litters include Brown and Blue Burmese as well as those of the new colours. Having had comparatively few kittens, so far the breeders have not contemplated a Provisional Standard of Points regarding coat and eye colour, but intend to keep type as for the recognised Brown and Blue Burmese.

SILVER TABBY FOREIGN

These cats are classified as Any Other Variety. In type they are similar to the Chestnut Brown Foreign or the Siamese, from which they are bred. Their Pattern is similar to the pattern of the British Silver Tabby.

The dam of these kittens is a particularly well marked Silver Tabby, while their sire is a Blue-Point son of Blue-Point parents. Both grandsires are well known for both Show quality and progeny—Champion Misselfore Ryken (Blue-Point) and Champion Gringo Silver Peregrine (Silver Tabby).



FOREIGN BLACK

The Foreign Black is registered as Any Other Variety in this country, although in Australia it is known as the Susuki. In type it is identical to the Chestnut Brown, the Foreign White or the Siamese. The coat lies close to the body and the eyes may be copper or bright green.

FOREIGN BLACK

Black Panther is sired by a Chocolate-Pointed son of Champion Briarry Macsuch and is out of a brown bred Foreign Black.



BLUE-CREAM TABBY

When cats of the Red Series are mated with cats of the Tabby Series the resultant litter can sometimes include Tortie Tabbies or their dilutions. Such cats are registered as Any Other Variety.

BLUE-CREAM TABBY

134 Mrs. J. Richards, PENSYLVA FILIGREE. Female. Born 8.5.67. Breeder, Exhibitor. Sire, Ch. Trailpark Ambrose (owner of Sire, Exhibitor). Dam, Pensylva Jungle Princess.

Filigree is a most attractive kitten, combining the beauty of the Tabby pattern and ticking with the colours of Blue and Cream. She inherits the Cream from her dam, who shows some red in her own coat and is herself out of a Blue-Cream from a wild mating. The sire of the kitten is a Blue from Blue parents.

Filigree has a tendency to mackerel tabby markings at present, but as there is no real definite line down the back it is thought that her markings will probably break down into spotting eventually. In this instance the Red and the Tabby series are both handed down from the dam Princess.



TRI-COLOUR

Such cats do make their appearance from time to time and, of course, the Tortie is also technically Tri-colour. When more than two colours appear they are usually in relation to a particular and expected combination of colours, i.e., Blue-Cream and White, Tabby and White, etc. They are registered as Any Other Variety.

TRI-COLOUR

135 Mrs. E. Allen Smith, GADEFORD HONEY. Female. Born 9.5.66. Breeder, Exhibitor. Sire, Champion Dalin Sabin (owner of Sire, Mrs. Barron). Dam, Gadeford Colleen.

Honey is a Short-Hair cat of British type and has never been previously exhibited. In the words of her breeder, the colours are Blue, Lavender and Cream. The Blue and Lavender are both patched and mingled, while the Cream is patched only. Honey arrived in a litter that was part of her owner's breeding programme for Self Brown Long-Hairs and was a complete surprise. Her sire is a Cream carrying Blue and her dam is a Black Short-Hair out of a Self Lavender and sired by a Blue.
