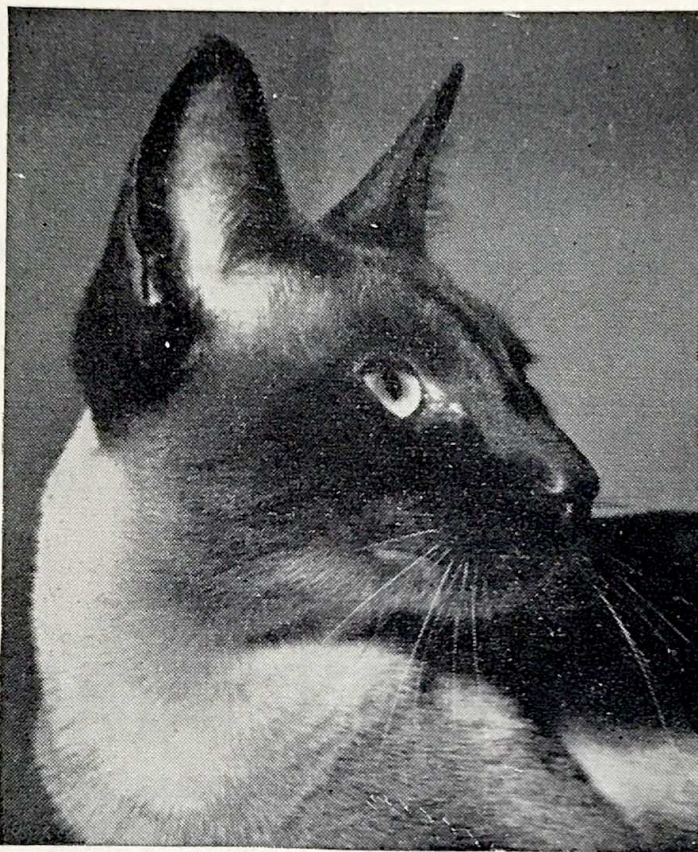

SIAMESE (SEAL-POINT):

The Seal-Point Siamese is of medium size with a long, svelte body. Proportionately slim legs and small oval feet. Tail long and tapering. The head should be long with width between the eyes, narrowing in straight lines to a fine muzzle. Ears should be large and pricked at base. The coat should be of fine texture, glossy and close lying. Body cream in colour, shading to a warm fawn on the back. The mask, ears, legs and tail dense clearly defined seal brown, the mask (except in kittens) connected by tracings with the ears. Eyes, oriental in shape, slanting towards the nose and of clear, brilliant deep blue.

SIAMESE (BLUE-POINTED)

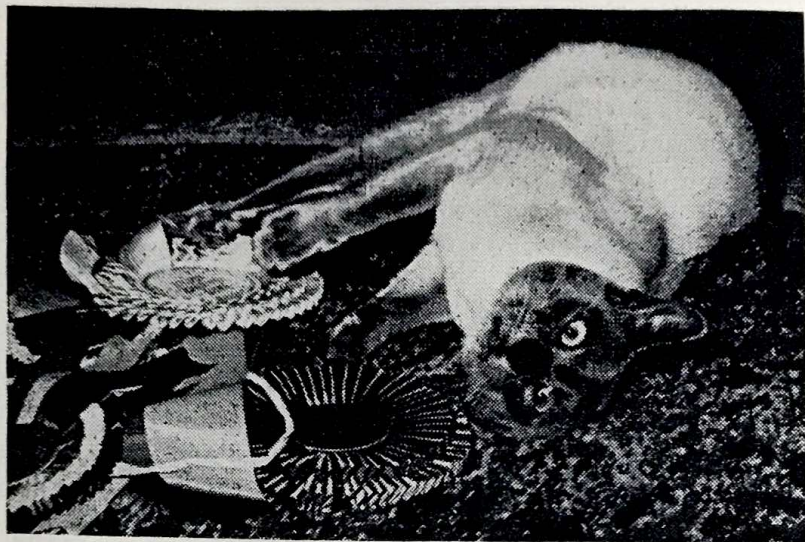
The Blue-Pointed Siamese is similar to the Seal in type. The body colour should be glacial white, shading into blue on the back. The points are blue, ears, mask, legs, paws and tail should all be the same colour, and eyes of clear, bright vivid blue.

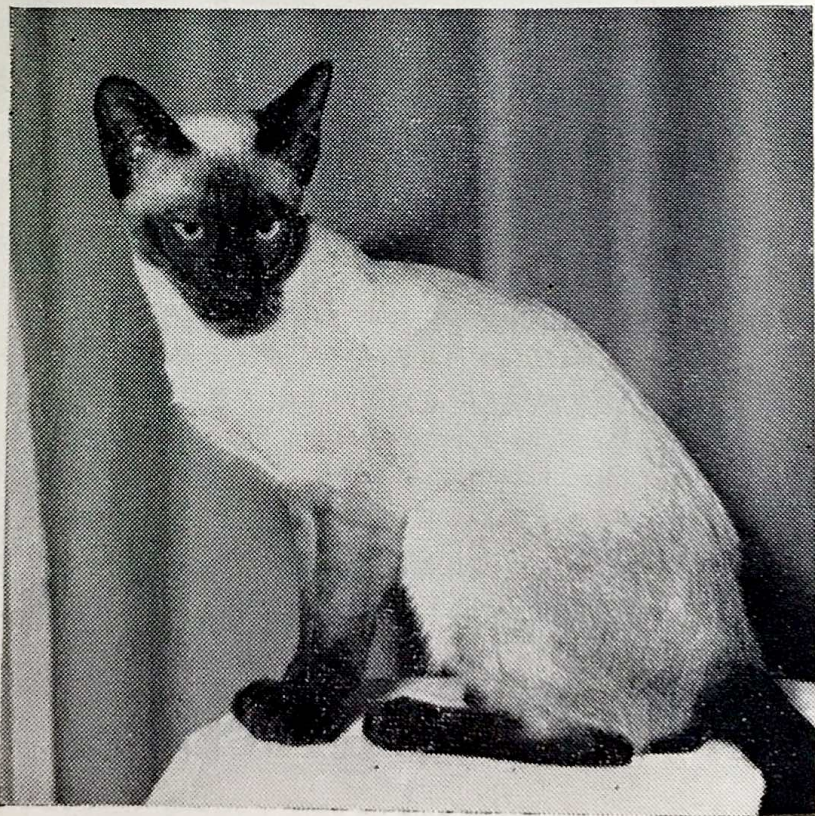

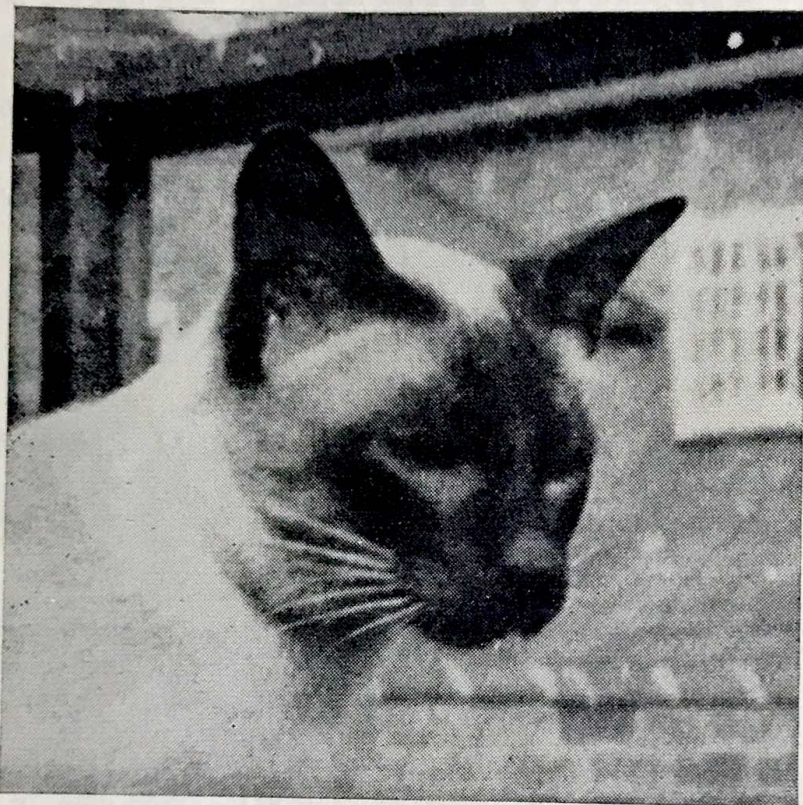

The coat should be of fine texture and glossy and close lying. Body colour ivory all over, shading if at all to colour of points. Mask, ears, legs and tail, milk chocolate. The ears should not be darker than the other points. Eyes, oriental in shape and of clear, bright, vivid blue.

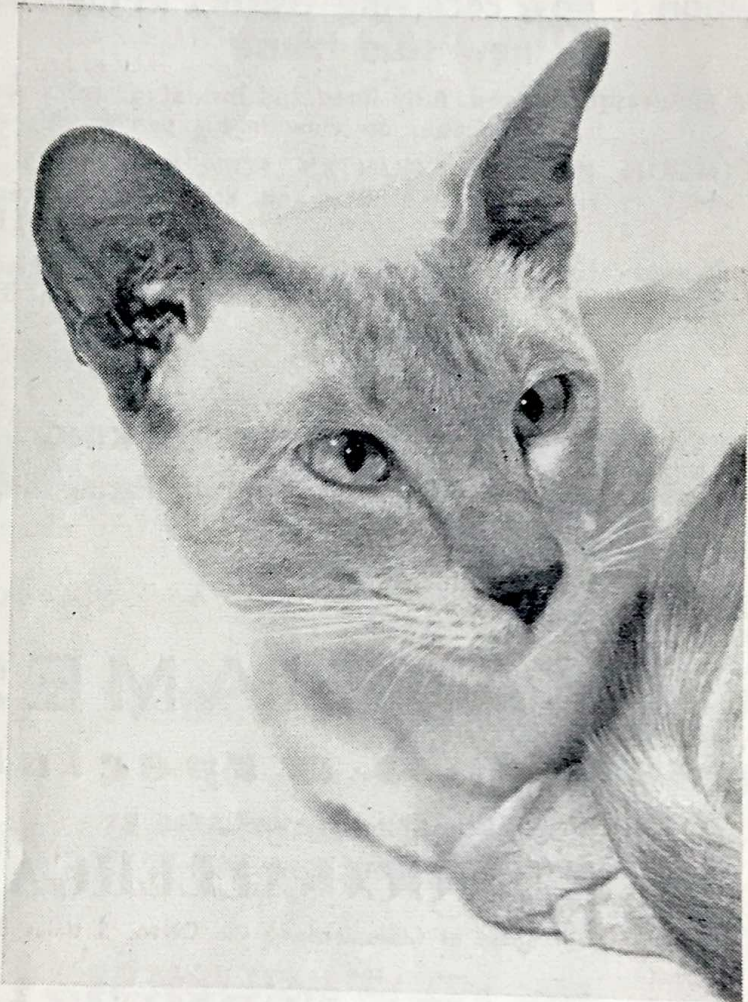

The coat should be of fine texture, glossy and close lying. Body colour white, shading if any gradually to apricot on back. Mask, ears, legs and tail of bright reddish-gold. Eyes oriental in shape of bright, vivid blue.

The Tortie-Point Siamese is of medium size with a long svelte body. Proportionately slim legs and small oval feet. Tail long and tapering. The head should be long with width between the eyes, narrowing in straight lines to a fine muzzle. Ears should be large and pricked at base. The coat should be of fine texture, i.e. glossy and close lying. The body colour should be cream shading to a warmer colour on the back. Points of seal brown and red or chocolate and red equally balanced with no white. Patches must be well defined with no blurring. Eyes oriental in shape of bright, vivid blue.

There are at present no Standards of Points for the varieties registered as Any Other Dilution. The cats can be shown in combined Open Classes, i.e., Choc-Tortie, Blue-Cream, Lilac-Cream and Cream, but no Challenge Certificates may be awarded. The following notes give an indication of the appearance of the cats and have been made from information provided by the breeders/exhibitors.



CREAM-POINT SIAMESE

The colour should not be hot but shows tabby markings as in the L.H. and S.H. creams. The nose leather and the pads are bright pink. The tail tends to be ringed with the darker shade of cream dominating right down from the spine. The feet and legs will also show faint tabby markings. The body colour is very pale—like creamy milk, shading tones with the points. The eyes are a brilliant but warm blue.

CREAM-POINT SIAMESE

169 Mrs. M. Baxter, EMBEE PUTSARAHKAM. Born 25.2.67. Breeder, Exhibitor. Sire, Embee T'Hahng Plah (owner of Sire, Mrs. Baxter). Dam, Embee Pee-Sao.

BLUE-CREAM-POINT SIAMESE

The mask is patched blue and cream. A blaze may appear, giving a harlequin appearance. Since the blue tends to diffuse, the patching may not be clearly defined. The ears are mottled blue and cream and the nose leather and pads are mottled grey and pink. The size of the mottling varies with the size of the mottling on the surrounding furred section and therefore some cats may appear to have nearly solid colour on the nose leather. The tail is patched and mingled with the blue and cream in an irregular pattern. The colour on the feet and legs is also mottled blue and cream but tends to be generally paler than on the mask and ears. The body colour is similar to that of a Blue-Point, but shading tends to be mottled and in bad cases of shading the cream mottled section is paler than that of the blue/fawn section. The eyes favour the blue of the Blue-Point.

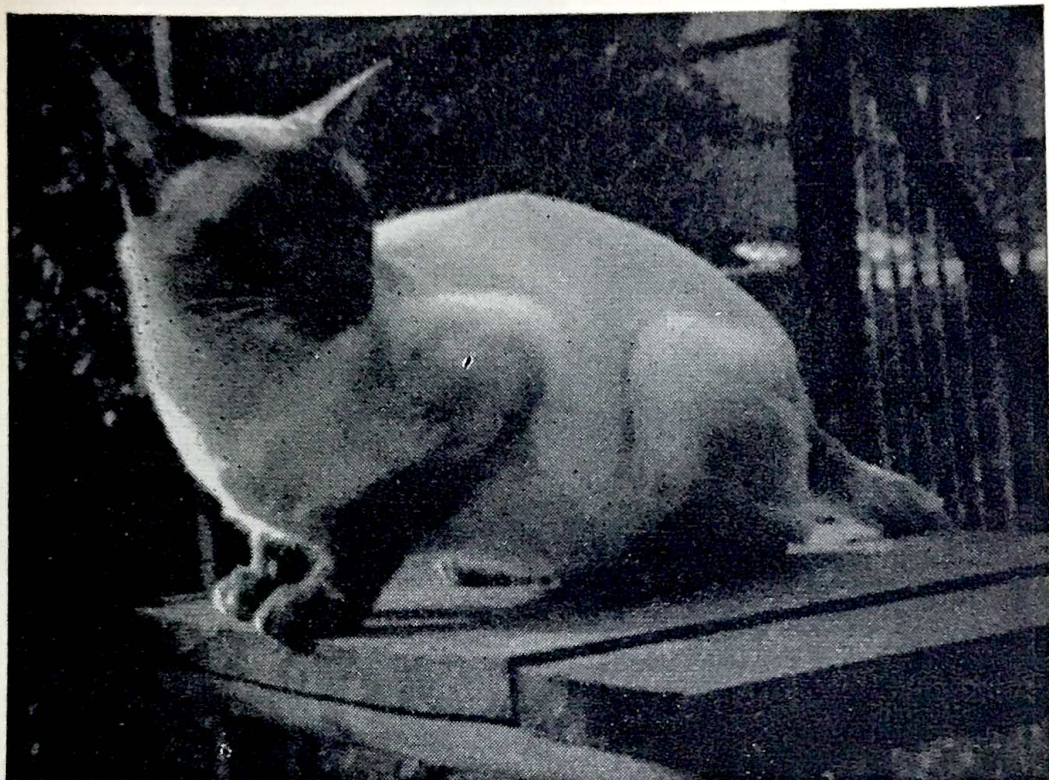

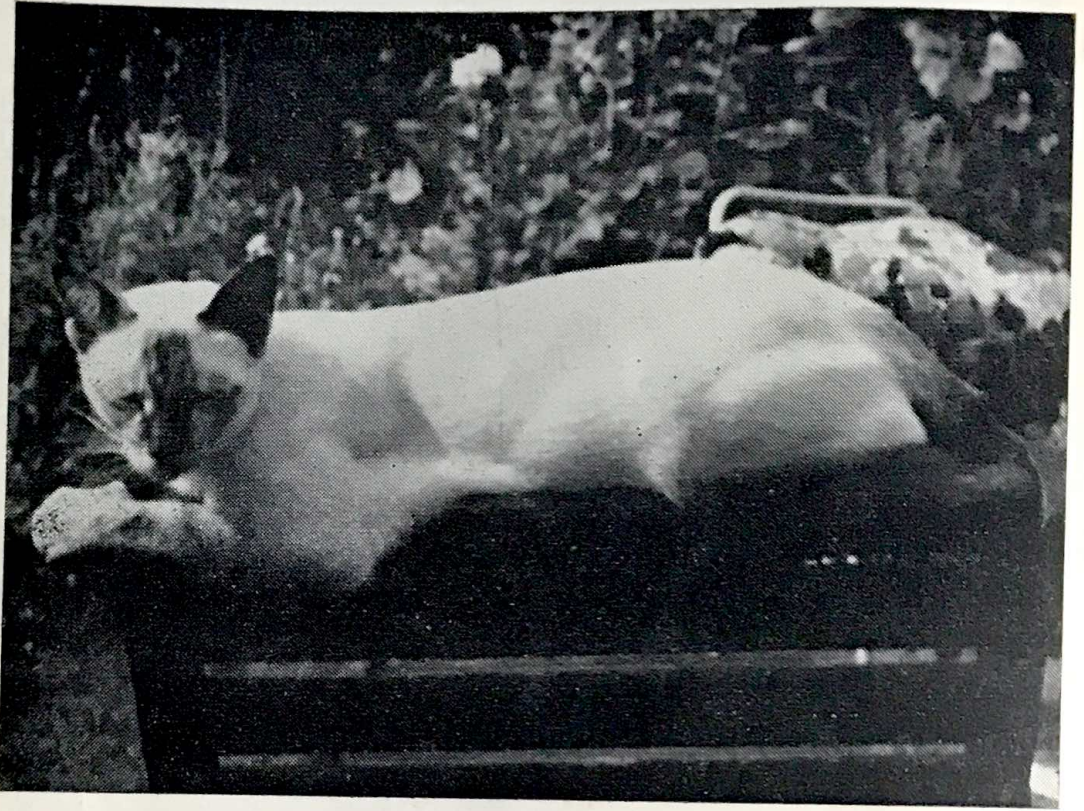

The nose leather and pads are mottled 'choc' pink and 'red' pink. The scale of the mottling varying as described under Blue-Cream-Point. The tail is patched and mingled choc. and tones of red. The colour on the legs tends to be generally paler than on the ears and mask, as is the case with a Self-Red-Point. The body colour is similar to that of the Chocolate-Point and the shading tends to be mottled and toning with the choc. and red. The eyes are a clear bright blue, favouring the colour of the Chocolate-Point, but perhaps holding a little more warmth.

The mask is patched and blended lilac and cream. A blaze may appear but in general the patching is not so defined as in the Seal Tortie-Point. The ears are mottled lilac and cream. The nose leather and pads are mottled in two tones of pink. The tail is patched and mingled lilac and cream in an irregular pattern. The colour on the feet and legs may be much paler than on the mask. The body colour is similar to that of a Lilac-Point and shading, if any, tends to be mottled. The eyes are a brilliant bright blue, a little less of a pinked tinge of the blue of the Lilac-Point.
