FOREWORD

It is probable that for many of our visitors to-day, this will be the first time they have been to a Cat Show, although many are held annually. As Cat Show Manager for the East of England Agricultural Society I welcome you, and thank you for your interest.

This Catalogue contains details of every exhibit—its owner, its registered name, sex, parents, breeder's name and date of birth. The number in parentheses after the exhibit's name indicates its breed and you will find a list of these immediately before the catalogue proper.

The Show is a comparatively small one, and it is held under licence from the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, the controlling body in the United Kingdom. Its title 'Exemption' means that the very strict rules relating to Championship Shows are relaxed, allowing cats and kittens to be grouped in classes for judging, whereas at Championship Shows separate classes have to be provided for every recognized breed of cat (and there are over 50!), both adult and kitten, and in addition separate classes for certain breeds of neuters are mandatory. At such Shows there will be at least 400, and often between 750 and 1,000 exhibits. A list of some of these major Shows will be found after these notes.

Nevertheless, in the Show to-day there are long-haired, short-haired and Siamese cats and kittens, and also some non-pedigree exhibits. I am quite sure that their owners will be only too pleased to answer your questions and to tell you about cats and shows, kittens and breeding, and the immense enjoyment they derive from their pets. Undoubtedly it is a rewarding hobby (not financially—ask any breeder!!), and the remarkable increase in numbers at Shows, both human and feline amply demonstrates the rapidly growing appreciation of cats. Perhaps the truth of the saying that a cat is incapable of an ungraceful movement is being realized by more and more people.

Two Championship status Clubs—the Suffolk and Norfolk and the Bedford and District have co-operated to provide the staff and administration to enable this Show to be held, and the Society is pleased to acknowledge the help given by both Clubs.

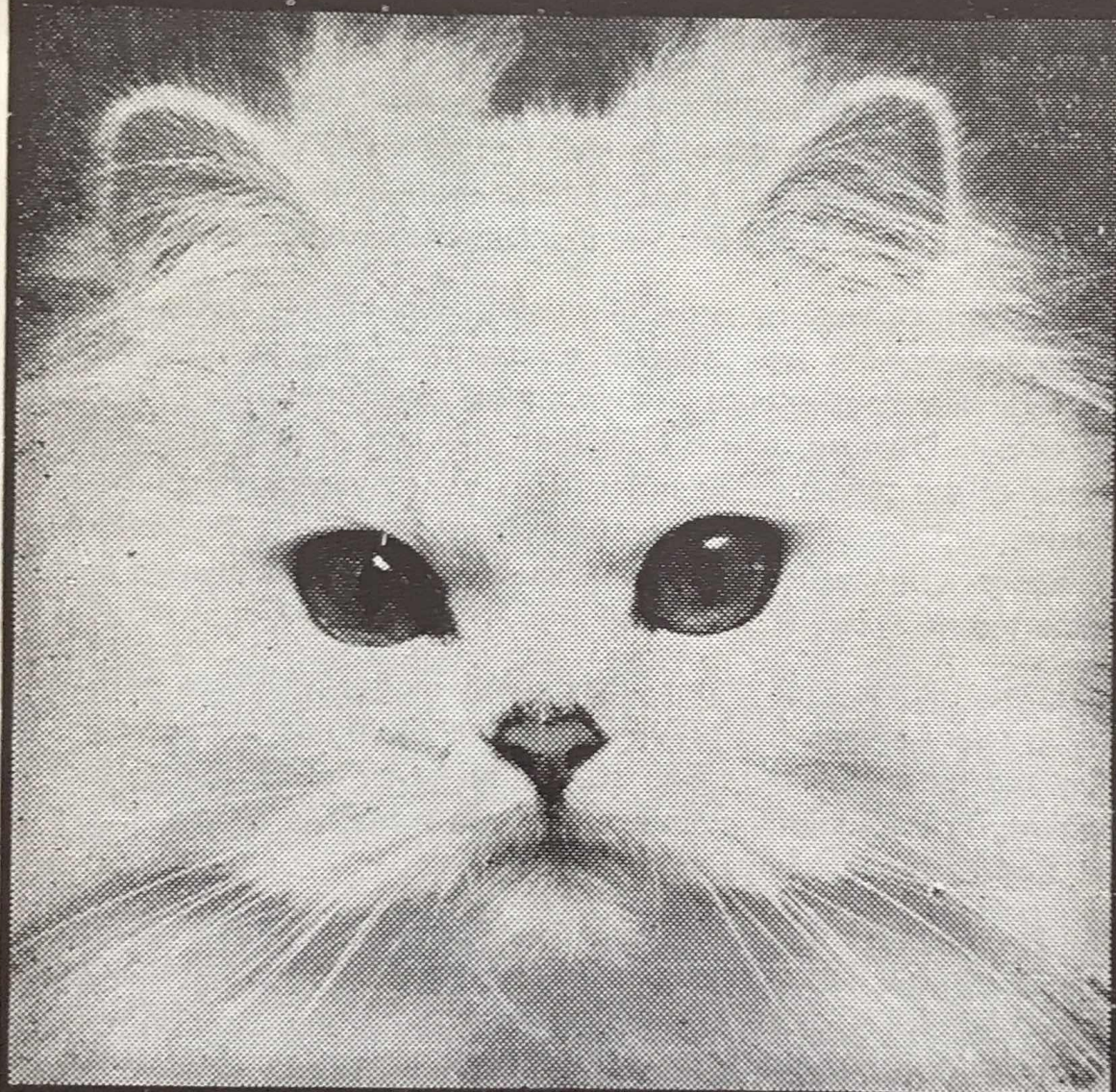

THE BEDFORD AND DISTRICT CAT CLUB

This Club, the younger of the two associated with to-day's Show was formed just ten years ago by a handful of cat-lovers in and around Bedford. Then, as now, several of its most active members are non-pedigree cat owners. Helped and guided particularly by two of its founder-members, who are now honoured with joint vice-Presidencies, the Club has prospered and grown to its present membership of well over 500, making it almost certainly the largest all-breeds Club in the country.

In 1970, quite shortly after completing its third year of affiliation to the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, it was granted Championship status, and the annual Show, the last in the season, is held late April or early May in the Queensway Hall, Dunstable.

The Club, managed by an enterprising and hard-working Committee, arranges a full calendar of events throughout the year; quarterly meetings—three "educational" and one purely social are held in Bedford, and a fifth open meeting is held in a town in one of the adjoining counties. This year Aylesbury has been chosen, and the date has been fixed for August 14th. In addition there is a supper-party and dance each year which is always well supported.

"Cat Chat" is the Club's four times yearly magazine which is sent free to every member; it provides an invaluable link between the Club and those members who are too far away to be able to join regularly in the various events, which are a feature of the Club's life. Copies are available here to-day.

The President of the Club is a distinguished member of the Council of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons, Henry Carter, Esq. He is also a past-President of the British Small Animal Veterinary Association, and the Club is very proud to have Mr. Carter as its President.

The welfare of less fortunate cats is never overlooked, and through its Vice-Presidents' Fund, and from the proceeds of Charity Classes at the Show, research and rescue organisations receive financial support.

New members are always welcome, and the Secretary will be delighted to meet anyone wishing to enquire, or better still join, at the Club stand here in the marquee.

THE SUFFOLK AND NORFOLK CAT CLUB

The Suffolk and Norfolk Cat Club was formed during the 1950's by a few enthusiasts who took great pride in the work they did in both breeding and exhibiting. Some of the founder members are still very active in the fancy and their stock is well known throughout the country.

Originally in its foundation years the club was the Suffolk Cat Club because most of the members lived either in Ipswich or the surrounding areas. It was a few years later that cat lovers in Norfolk requested that the club expand its activities to cover both counties. East Anglia does not have the large population that many other counties do although Norfolk and Suffolk have many square miles within their boundaries.

This major disadvantage could quite easily have thwarted the founder members of the club because of the difficulties encountered by members attending meetings, social functions etc., but the determination was strong enough to overcome any setbacks which occurred.

The early show venues were in Ipswich and the shows were most friendly and enjoyable. Our membership included a large number of household pet owners who joined in all the activities of the club and whose exhibits on the showbench were a credit to them. Today the Suffolk and Norfolk Cat Club show enjoys Championship status and the comment is frequently made on the friendliness which exists within the club.

This is the result of the efforts of the committee and all the club membership who see the cat fancy today as a section of the population who enjoy the same hobby and can meet socially but at the same time look after the welfare of cats generally.

We thank the founder members for the good start they gave the club whose membership is now approximately 250.

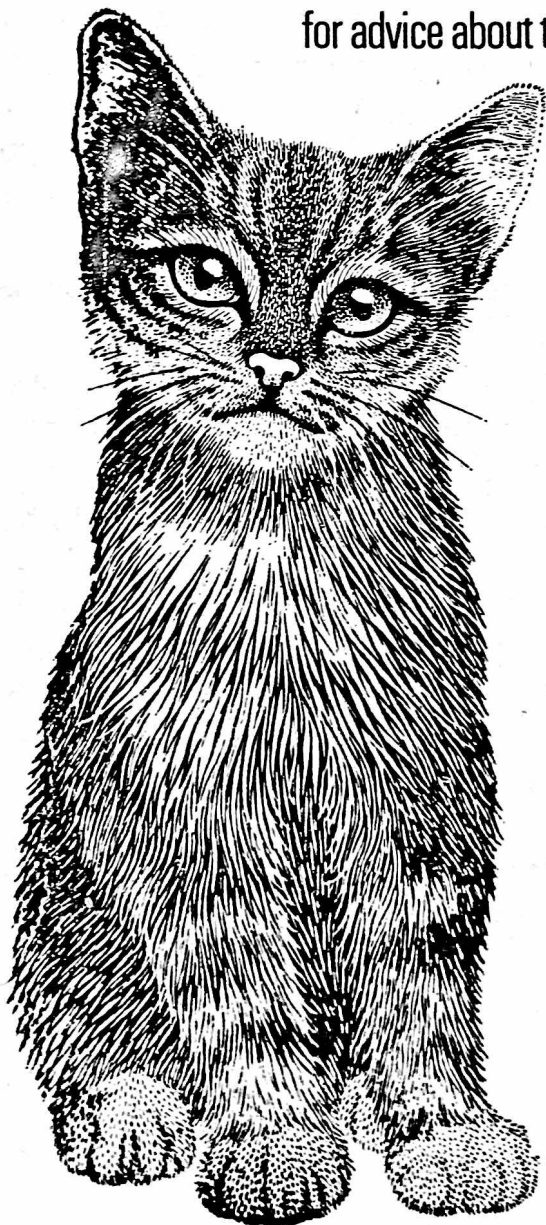

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

1. **Breeders.** For cats and kittens bred by the exhibitor.
2. **Novice.** For cats and kittens that have not won a First Prize under G.C.C.F. Rules. Wins as kittens do not disqualify in Cat Classes unless the Class is for Cats and Kittens.
3. **Senior** For cats and kittens two years old and over on the day of the Show.
4. **Junior.** For cats under two years old on the day of the Show.
5. **Limit.** For cats and kittens that have not won more than four First Prizes.
6. **Special Limit.** For cats and kittens that have not won more than two First Prizes.
7. **Maiden.** For cats and kittens that have not won a First, Second or Third Prize at Shows held under G.C.C.F. Rules.
8. **Debutante.** For cats and kittens that have never been exhibited at a Show held under G.C.C.F. Rules.
9. **Kittens.** For kittens under nine calendar months old on the day of the Show. Kittens under three calendar months may not be exhibited.

Prize money will not be given in any of the Open Classes; instead the East of England Show Special Rosettes will be awarded to each first, second and third prize winner and also the Reserve.
