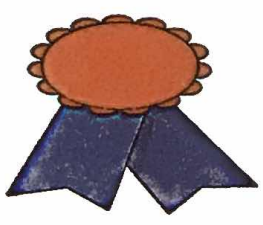

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Show is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. A copy of the Rules is obtainable from the GCCF Offices, 4-6 Penel Orliou, Bridgwater, Somerset TA6 3PG. Price £1.50 and must be read by all exhibitors. Ignorance of the Rules will not be an acceptable excuse for their breach.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of the exhibits and for entering them in the correct classes. Obvious errors in this catalogue should be drawn to the Show Manager's attention during the day, and you may also correct your entry form up to the close of the show. The Show closes at 5.00pm. No cat may be removed from its pen before this time. Any exhibitor interfering with or removing any cat from its pen during the show, except with the consent of the Show Manager will forfeit any award that may be due to his or her exhibit.

THE COMMITTEE RESERVE TO THEMSELVES THE RIGHT TO:-

1. Appoint other judges should those advertised not be able to fulfil their engagements and to appoint further judges should they be required.
2. Fix and limit the number of exhibits at the Show and to accept or refuse entry without giving reason.
3. Cancel, amalgamate or divide classes.
4. Publish a catalogue of the Show containing information as to the exhibits and the names and addresses of exhibitors.
5. Retain a percentage of the Entry Fees to cover essential expenses in the event of the Show being cancelled for any reason.
6. All Exhibitors' property is left in the Show Hall at the owners risk.

CORRESPONDENCE

All correspondence must be accompanied by a stamped, addressed envelope. Any complaint relating to the Show must be forwarded to the Show Manager within seven (7) days of the Show.

JUDGES

Judges are empowered to withhold any prizes or championship in any class if the exhibits do not, in their opinion, possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be awarded from the judge's slip, not from any catalogue or prize card. In an emergency judges may be changed during the course of the Show, with the consent of the Show Manager.

Veterinary Clearance Certificates

Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected please note the following points:-

1. When sending your clearance certificate to the Veterinary Office, please include your copy of the rejection slip.
2. Please DO NOT send these certificates by recorded delivery post as this can cause considerable delays in the receipt of your certificates. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer please enclose a stamped addressed postcard acknowledging receipt, for signature, and this will be returned to you.
3. Exhibitors should not attend shows until they have received a letter accepting and confirming clearance from the Veterinary Officer. It is recommended that this letter be taken to shows within one month of issue.

If an exhibit is unable to attend the Show for whatever reason, the Show Manager must be notified in writing. No fees will be returned after the Official Closing date of entries as published in the Schedule.

AWARDS

COUNTERSIGNING OF CERTIFICATES

In the event of a judge change of an Open Class occurring after the closing date of the Show, and provided that the exhibitor informs the Show Manager prior to judging that a certificate has previously been awarded by the replacement judge, the Show Manager shall appoint one other judge who shall judge the cat, and if the cat is considered worthy, countersign the Certificate, which shall then count towards Championship status.

ADVICE TO EXHIBITORS AS FROM 1.6.92

- a) You are advised about purchasing any shampoo that changes a cat's coat colour as this can lead to disqualification.
- b) Homeopathic Vaccinations are not acceptable to the GCCF for Vetting-in
- c) Any alterations to your Show Entry must be in writing which will be attached to the entry form by the Show Manager. You may also make corrections up to the close of the Show.
- d) Kittens under 14 weeks may not now be shown.
- e) Any person whose cats have been rejected under Section C or D must not officiate as a Judge/Steward or in any other capacity which requires the handling of cats at Shows until a Clearance Certificate, as required by the GCCF, has been obtained.
- f) The use of small battery driven fans in pens can be dangerous and could also be considered a distinguishing mark.
- g) Please note that in addition to the Classes you have entered your cat may be handled for the purpose of assessing candidates in the GCCF appointment scheme.
- h) Queens who have kitted within 12 weeks of the date of the Show may not be shown.

NOTICE OF CHANGE

An announcement in "Cats" of any alterations or additions made to the schedule or in these regulations shall be sufficient notice thereof.

RULE ON BITING AT SHOWS (Effective 1.6.88)

Any cat biting or inflicting injury by deliberately scratching a Judge, Veterinary Surgeon, Steward or other Show Official must be reported to the Show Manager. The Show Manager must withdraw the cat from the Show and shall inform the Owner of the cat in writing, sending a copy to the Secretary of the GCCF. If the cat was defending itself in exceptional and frightening circumstances, that information should be given to the Secretary of the GCCF for consideration by the Executive Committee. If the cat is reported at any subsequent Show, it shall be disqualified from all future Shows unless the Executive Committee rule otherwise.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

OPEN CLASS CATS	Open to all of the specified breeds. 9 calendar months old and over on the day of the Show.
KITTENS	Not less than 14 weeks and under 9 months old on the day of the Show.
NEUTERS	Neutered cats, male or female must be registered. Neuters may only enter Neuter Classes and may not compete with entire cats or kittens except in Club Classes which are scheduled to include neuters.
NOVICE	Exhibits that have not won a First Prize in any class at a Show held under GCCF Rules.
LIMIT	Exhibits that have not won more than four First Prizes in any classes at shows held under GCCF Rules.
SPECIAL LIMIT	Exhibits that have not won more than two First Prizes in any classes at shows held under GCCF Rules.
DEBUTANTE	Exhibits that have never been shown at a show held under GCCF Rules.
MAIDEN	Exhibits that have not won a First, Second or Third Prize in any class held under GCCF Rules.
BREEDERS	Exhibits bred by exhibitor(s).
JUNIOR	Cats under 2 years old on day of Show.
SENIOR	Cats 2 years old and over on day of Show.
VETERAN	Cats 5 years old and over on day of Show.
RADIUS	For cats and kittens living under 25 miles from the show hall.
VISITORS	For cats and kittens living over 25 miles from the show hall.
ARISTOCRAT	Exhibits with 1 or 2 Challenge/Premier Certificates.
BRACE	2 exhibits from the same household
TEAM	3 exhibits from the same household
PURE BRED BLUE	Exhibits with at least 4 generations of exclusively Blue Parentage

Champions and Premiers

The Title of Champion shall be granted to a cat winning three Champion Challenge Certificates at three shows under three separate judges. A GCCF Certificate will be offered for each/Neuter Open Class of recognised breeds with Championship status.

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS & PREMIER OF PREMIERS

The title of Grand Champion shall be granted to a cat winning three Champion Challenge Certificates at three shows under three separate judges. To compete in a Champion of Champions Class a cat must be a full Champion. A Champion cat may be entered in its ordinary breed Open Class and in the Champion of Champions Class. Only one prize with a Reserve in case of disqualification will be awarded to Male or Female.

The title of Grand Premier shall be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as those for Grand Champion.

HOUSEHOLD PET SECTION

NO CAT OR KITTEN REGISTERED WITH THE GCCF MAY ENTER THIS SECTION
Cats:- Over 9 months of age. Kittens:- 14 weeks to 9 months old.
All Household Pets entered in Adult Classes (i.e over 9 months old) must be neutered or spayed.

Judging

Judging will start at 10.00am prompt. The hall will not be cleared, only the aisles, exhibitors will be permitted around the edges and at all stalls. The show will be open to the public at 11.00am.

BIS Flower Baskets

This year we are NOT offering the flower baskets to BIS winners, as we believe exhibitors will prefer the Best in Show Crystal, as a longer lasting momento of their win.

CATERING

Tea Coffee and snacks will be available all day at the Show Hall.

Sadly this year one of our Vice-Presidents died.

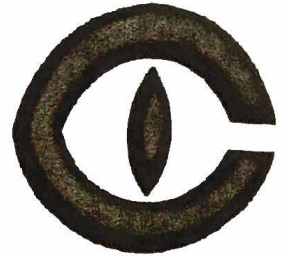

EXHIBITORS - If your cat has won a Champion or Premier title at a GCCF Championship Show, please make your claim to the GCCF office (address above). Please include the cat's name, breed number, sex, breeder's name, owner's name and address, together with the names and dates of the three shows, and awarding judges' names. All claims are acknowledged, and periodically a list of Champions etc. is published in CATS, shortly after which medals are sent to the owners from the GCCF office.

APPLYING FOR A PREFIX - Breeding prefixes cost £60 (with effect from 1 January 1999) and applicants must be a member of a GCCF affiliated cat club at the time of application. Forms are available from the office.

REGISTRATIONS AND TRANSFERS - Forms for both are available from the office.

CERTIFICATE OF ENTIRETY - All male cats used at stud must have a Certificate of Entirety deposited with the GCCF, prior to registration of kittens. To obtain an official Certificate of Entirety, send a large stamped addressed envelope to the office, together with the registration number and name of the cat. No fee is charged by the GCCF. We recommend you keep a photocopy for your own records and to show to owners of visiting queens.

THE BLUE PERSIAN CAT SOCIETY CELEBRATES ITS DIAMOND SHOW

This year the 'Blue' celebrates its Diamond Show. The breed show has always been an important showcase for this lovely breed, with a win at the 'Blue' long considered by breed specialists to be most prestigious.

The first 'Blue' Show was held in 1931 – quite an impressive step for the Club to make in the year of the Great Depression. Following a break during the war years, the BPCS shows resumed in 1948 and have continued almost unbroken up to today.

The history of the Society however goes back to the turn of the Century and it is in fact '*The oldest Longhair Cat Club in the World*'. The Society, founded in 1901, was a founder member of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and as such it is one of a privileged few clubs to have assured representation to that body.

The Blue's founder, Miss Frances Simpson, became the Society's first President. She was closely associated with the Society for the rest of her life and it is reputed that her allegiance to the Society was so deep that from the founding of the 'Blue' she never joined another club. The longest serving Honorary Secretary of the Society was almost certainly Miss J.M. Fisher (Eveley) of Hampshire. She served in that position from 1924 to 1951.

Today the Society has an active Committee reflecting an amazing range of experience in the Cat Fancy and dedication to the breed.

The Blue Persian

The Blue Persian is one of the oldest recognised pedigree breeds of cat. It can trace its origins back to ancient times and is thought to have originated in the area then known as Persia. It has been the companion of discerning cat lovers for generations, even Queen Victoria is known to have owned one.

Accounts differ as to whether the first Blues were shown in the 1870s by the Gresham sisters or later in the 1880s by Miss Frances Simpson. However, the first classes were offered for Blues in 1889 at the Crystal Palace Show. The following year these classes were split male/female. For many decades the Blues were considered the standard bearers for the Persian breed group and were used in breeding programmes for other breeds to retain 'type' and overall quality.

The Blue Persian should be a large, solid boned animal with thick legs, strong shoulders and broad head. The overall appearance of the head should be rounded and flat in profile. The ears should be set low and close to the skull to maintain the impression of a rounded head. The cat should have a short broad nose and a good chin to balance the face. The eyes of deep orange to copper should be round, bold and expressive. The body should be cobby or 'square' in shape with a short full tail. The distinguishing feature of the 'Blue' is of course its profuse blue coat. This may vary in tone from a medium to a pale silvery blue, but should not be dark or 'grey' in tone.

The original Standard of Points for Blues, put forward by the Society in 1901 set the points for coat at 30, but this was later changed to 30 points for coat colour and 20 points for condition. More recently this was reduced to 30 to create uniformity between the Self LH standards.

As a companion a Blue Persian is loving and intelligent. Although their placid natures can often be mistaken for disinterest or 'something lacking in the brains department', they can be playful and surprisingly calculating when they want something but will rarely tolerate being handled roughly - and why should they? While they enjoy the freedom of a safe enclosed garden, they will adapt quite happily to living in a flat or as 'an indoor' pet. This of course ensures a greater degree of safety and their coats are easier to manage.

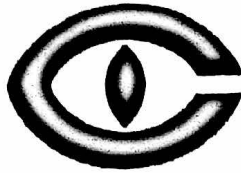

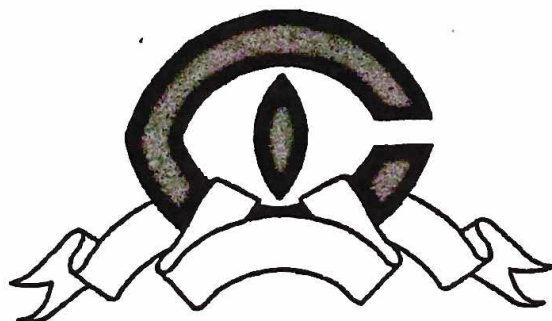

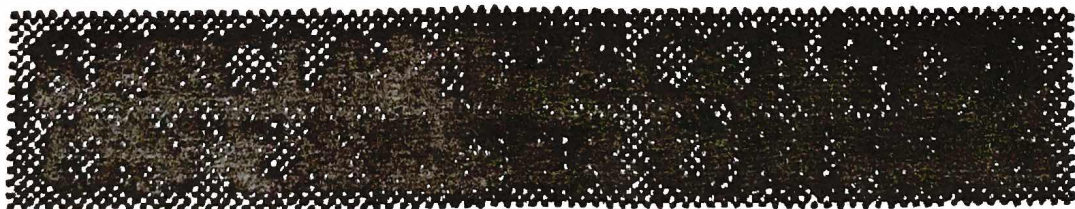
