The Trustees are delighted to announce the closure of the Ringworm Appeal. The Trust is now holding sufficient funds to support the ringworm vaccine research for the full three year programme. Ann Robinson has been working on this research since October 1996 at Bristol School of Veterinary Medicine.

The Trustees are now asking for support for a new project or series of projects to promote the health of cats by carrying out genetic research. Relatively little work has been undertaken in this field and it is a subject that has come to the fore recently with the European Union's Convention on the Breeding of Pet Animals which pinpoints several areas of concern.

The Trustees are hoping to identify a project and have the work underway in the second half of 1998. The funding required will be £10,000 each year
