PLEASE SUPPORT THE GENOME MAP PROJECT

The Trustees have now chosen the second project after an excellent response from the Veterinary Schools and organisations approached. It has been decided to support the project proposed by Dr Matthews Binns of the Animal Health Trust.

The Animal Health Trust has been working on the production of genome maps for horses and dogs. These maps are an essential tool for the study of genetics in any species and Dr Binns will now extend this study to produce a map for cats. This work has already started in the United States and it will be a great asset for cat breeders in this country to have the benefits of this research easily available to them. The project will produce information about inherited disease and enable such problems to be identified by a simple blood test. Programs can then be developed for the elimination of the disease from the breed in the most positive and caring way. The work on the genome map and the following research will take time and funding from other sources but it will be the Cat Welfare Trust grant which will enable the work to commence.

Work started on the project at the beginning of the year 2000 and will be funded for two years. The Trustees need your support to provide money to enable them to make this grant and to produce further funds to undertake future projects for the benefit of our cats. The excellent response received for this project has confirmed the Trustees' belief that there are many worthwhile projects needing their support in the future. It is now possible to obtain a tax rebate on millenium gifts under the Gift Aid rules. Details of this scheme are available from your local tax office.

The final results from the Ringworm Project are now available.
