SHOW RULES, PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

This Show is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. As a This Show is held under the Rules of the Copy of these Rules are not included with this Schedule, all exhibitors are reminded that they should read Section 4 of the Show Rules, as they will be strictly applied. Ignorance will not be accepted as an excuse for a breach of the Rules. (Copies may be obtained from the GCCF Offices, 5, Kings Castle

The Committee reserve the right to:

- The Committee reserve the right to:

 (a) Appoint other judges should the advertised be unable to fulfil their engagements and to appoint further judges if deemed necessary.
- (b) Fix and limit the number of exhibits at the show and refuse entry without giving a reason.
- (c) Cancel, amalgamate or divide classes.
- (d) Disqualify cats entered in the wrong classes by the exhibitor.
- (e) Refuse admission to the Show Hall without giving a reason.
- (f) Retain a percentage of the entry fees to cover essential expenses, in the event of the show being cancelled for any reason.
- (g) Publish a catalogue of the Show containing information as to the exhibits and names and addresses of exhibitors.

Exhibits received into the show hall are received on condition that the Society shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits, boxes or baskets or in any other way. The Show closes at 5pm or earlier at the Show Managers discretion. No cat may be removed without the permission of the Show Manager. Failure to observe this rule will lead to disqualification and forfeiture of any prize money and awards won. There will be no early removal passes issued. All correspondence must be accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope if a reply is required. Any complaint related to the Show must be forwarded to the Show Manager within seven days of the show.

VETERINARY

Any exhibit rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon must be removed by its owner and the Entry Fees are forfeit. If in the Veterinary Surgeon's opinion, it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same household and owner shall be debarred from attending the show. The Veterinary Surgeon's decision is final.

VETERINARY CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES

Where an exhibit has been rejected or disqualified by a Veterinary Surgeon, the Show Managers shall obtain from the vet, the reasons, and accordingly notify the GCCF within 48 hours of the Show, ensuring a copy of the rejection form is forwarded to the exhibitor concerned.

Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected at shows please note the following points:

- (1) When sending your clearance certificate to the Veterinary Officer, please include your copy of the rejection slip.
- (2) Please DO NOT send these certificates by recorded delivery as this can cause considerable delays in receipt of your certificate. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer, please enclose a stamped addressed postcard for acknowledgement receipt, this will be signed and returned to you.
- (3) Exhibitors should not attend Shows until they have received a letter from the Secretary confirming clearance. It is recommended that this letter be taken to shows within a month of the issue of the clearance letter

JUDGES AND JUDGING

JUDGES AND JUDGING

Judges are empowered to withhold any prize, award or certificate in any class, if the exhibits do not, in their opinion, possess and from any their opinion, possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be awarded from the judge's slip, not from any catalogue or prize and a ludge. catalogue or prize card. An exhibitor may not approach a Judge, or enter into conversation with a Judge, until that Judge's care.

In the event of a change of judge of an Open class occurring after the closing date of the show, and provided that the cuttility of the previously provided that the exhibitor informs the Show Manager prior to judging that a certificate has previously been awarded by the state. been awarded by the replacement judge, the Show Manager shall appoint one other judge who shall

The wins as a Kitten do not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter. The wins as an adult do not count when exhibit is neutered and shown. Merit Awards do not count as 'wins' for entering restricted classes.

Olympian Class

In order to enter "Olympian" class your cat must be an Imperial Grand Champion/Imperial Grand Premier/Imperial Grand Master Cat. Once your cat has attained IGRCH/IGRPR/IGRMC status, it may only enter Olympian classes and be considered for Best of Breed, if BOB is held.

Imperial Class

In order to enter the "Imperial" class your cat must be a Grand Champion/Grand Premier/Grand Master Cat. Once a cat has attained GRCH/GRPR/GRMC status, it may only enter the Imperial class and be considered for Best of Breed, if BOB is held. Your cat must have been awarded 5 Imperial certificates from 5 different judges to attain the title Imperial Grand Champion/Grand Premier. Reserve certificates will be awarded.

TITLES AND/OR MEDALS can be ordered by email or post to the address above. Title & Medal claim forms are available to download from the GCCF website. If applying by email please include the Title claimed, cat's name, breed number, sex, breeder's name, owners name and address, together with the names and dates of the qualifying shows and awarding judges' names. Title lists are published on the web site.

MEDALS COST £16.50 per medal including 1 free bar (excluding Olympian bars), £8 per subsequent bar. Olympian bars (Bronze, Silver or Gold) are £10, if a medal is required with the Olympian bar then the fee is £26.50. UK Medals are £20. Payment with orders please.

Owners of cats achieving the Champion/Premier, Grand Champion/Grand Premier title under GCCF and GCCF of Ireland Rules may claim "International" status for that title, by writing to the GCCF Office enclosing written confirmation of having gained the title under GCCF of Ireland Rules. This written confirmation must be signed by the Secretary and stamped with the GCCF of Ireland's Seal.

APPLYING FOR A PREFIX - Breeding prefixes cost £75, for overseas residents the cost is £100 and applicants must be a member of a GCCF affiliated cat club at the time of application. Forms available from the office or online.

CENTIFICATE OF ENTIRETY - All male cats used at stud must have a Certificate of Entirety supplied to the GCCF signed by a Vet, prior to registration of kittens. This must contain the microchip number of the cat, verified at the time of examination and the Vet's practice stamp.

A Certificate of Entirety form can be downloaded from the GCCF website or by sending an s.a.e to the GCCF whose the the charged by the GCCF. We recommend you keep a photocopy for your own records and to show to owners of visiting queens.

#ATING CERTIFICATES - Section 1 Rule 3d (effective 1 June 2002) When a litter is registered, the application register must be accompanied by a copy of the certificate of mating unless the person registering the kitten(s) is also the registered owner of the sire. (Rule added 24.10.2001) The owner of the stud cat must provide a Cartricate of Mating to the owner of the gueen upon collection of the gueen (amended/effective 29.10.03).

Cat Welfare Trust

The Oak Fancy's own Charity. established 1988 Registered Charity No. 800719

The Cat Welfare Trust is the Fancy's own charity, set up by the GCCF in 1988. The Trust Deed was written to enable funds to be used for the widest possible range of activities to benefit cats. Currently the work of cat rescue is undertaken by GCCF Member Cat Clubs and so the Trust has turned to other ways of improving cat welfare.

Three projects have been completed so far, all of which have been funded because the subjects were of particular interest to pedigree cat owners and were not likely to attract commercial funding in their initial stages.

The first of these was a Ph.D. research project to study the preparation of a vaccine for ringworm and was undertaken by Ann Robinson at Bristol University Veterinary School. The second - the Genome Project was undertaken by Dr Matthew Binns of the Animal Health Thist and resulted in the identification and analysis of 211 markers on the feline genome map. The third - a study into feline chronic gingivostomatitis - was carried out by Kitty Industry at the University of Liverpool. Chronic gingivostomatitis is a condition familiar to many out memors, this is a very painful disease affecting the gums and mouths of pet cats causing infiammation and ulceration and there is currently no cure for this condition. Kitty's research has established a link between this condition and FCV reinforcing the need for regular vaccination. Kitty's thesis summary can be seen on the GCCF website.

the study should also objectively determine relative levels of inbreeding in various breeds and whether the gene pool is dangerously narrow putting specific breeds at increased risk of inherited disorders and disease susceptibilities. Results of this latter part of the study should supplement the information available to the BACs when they look at their breeding policies and help encourage best practise.

The Trust is dependent on donations from the Clubs and members of the Fancy and so it is easy to see that in order to be able to make grants large enough to make a difference to cats' lives we rely on you for all the financial support possible. 
